SUMMARY: The above individuals have been recommended by their respective District Commissioners (District 2: former Commissioner Jeff Koons; District 6: Commissioner Santamaria) for appointment/reappointment to the above named advisory boards for the terms indicated. <u>Countywide</u> (LB)

Background and Justification: The Fair Housing/Equal Employment Board is comprised of nine (9) members: seven (7) district and two (2) at-large. They promote and encourage fair treatment and equal opportunity in housing, public accommodation and employment for all persons. The diversity of the current board members is: 1 white female, 1 Hispanic female, 1 black male, 2 white males; and 2 black females. Two (2) seats are currently vacant.

The EMS Council is comprised of 18 members who include 11 members that represent the various components of the EMS system with specific requirements and seven (7) members that are Commission District Consumer appointments. The EMS Council provides recommendations for improving Emergency Medical Services in Palm Beach County. The diversity of the current board members is: 13 white males, 1 black male, and 1 white female. Three (3) seats are currently vacant.
