Summary: At its June 23, 2010 meeting, the Audit Committee reviewed the applications and resumes received from nine individuals wishing to serve on the Internal Audit Committee and found each applicant qualified to serve on the Committee. The Board of County Commissioners adopted Ordinance 2010-006 at its March 23, 2010 meeting. The Ordinance requires appointment of five members to serve on the Internal Audit Committee to replace the current seven member committee. The Ordinance also requires the Audit Committee to make recommendations to the BCC regarding qualified candidates. The Audit Committee also recommends that the BCC select individuals representing both the racial and ethnic diversity of the county as well as a diversity of talent and expertise for membership on the committee. (PFK)

Background and Justification: The Audit Committee was established in August, 1987 by resolution R-87-1226. In February, 2005 the Audit Committee was restructured and a new process for approval of the two citizen members of the Committee was established by Resolution R-2005-0372. Ordinance 2010-006, adopted March 23, 2010, eliminated the former 7 member audit committee and established a new five member audit committee consisting of individuals who are independent of the County organization and have experience in business or finance; government accounting, auditing, operations or financial management; or other relevant experience. Applications from interested individuals meeting the required qualifications were solicited and nine individuals submitted applications to serve on the Internal Audit Committee. The current audit committee reviewed the qualifications of all the applicants and determined that all nine were eligible to serve and recommends the BCC appoint five of the nine to the Internal Audit Committee.

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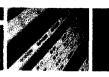
