I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Twelfth Amendment to contract with CGI Technologies and Solutions, Inc. (formerly named American Management Systems, Inc.) (R2002-1782), to extend the ending date from December 31, 2010 to December 30, 2011, at no additional cost to the County.

Summary: The Twelfth Amendment is an extension to allow additional time for completion of the deliverables specified in the original contract, including Vendor Self Service and modification No. 11. <u>CGI Technologies and Solutions, Inc. is based in Fairfax, VA.</u> This Amendment provides for disclosure of County Ordinance No. 2009-049 establishing the Office of the Inspector General. <u>Countywide</u> (PFK)

Background and Justification: On October 2, 2002, the Board approved the migration of the County's Financial System from the mainframe-based LGFS version to the web-based Advantage System. The implementation and installation of the Vendor Self Service module is still pending due to a mutual decision by the County and the vendor. The Twelfth Amendment extends the contract to provide time required for work on the Vendor Self Service module now scheduled for completion in 2011.

The Twelfth Amendment also provides additional time for modification #11 which provides the ability to systematically handle mass reorganization or changes in Fund types in an efficient manner. Broward County is currently implementing the Vendor Self Service module for their Advantage Financial System. This extension will allow Palm Beach County to evaluate Broward County's experience implementing and using this module.
