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New Provost named for Palm Beach Community College at Boca Raton

(Boca Raton, Fla. – Aug. 22, 2007) Dr. Bernadette Mendonez Russell, a former economist with more than 20 years of higher education experience, has been named the new provost of Palm Beach Community College's Boca Raton campus.

Russell was appointed by PBCC President Dennis P. Gallon after a nationwide search. She comes to PBCC from Marywood University in Scranton, Pa., where she has served as Dean of the School of Continuing Education since 2001. She takes leadership of the 6,000-student campus Sept. 4, and replaces Dr. Celeste Beck who retired earlier this year. "I'm very excited. It's a great opportunity for me to assume the position of provost of the Boca Raton campus because when I toured it, it looked like it was a very dynamic campus, and the people are friendly. I really like the atmosphere," she said.

Russell has extensive experience with community colleges and has spent much of her career in administrative positions with Onondaga Community College in Syracuse, N.Y. She taught economics for 10 years before beginning her administrative career in 1989 as the director of institutional research and planning at Onondaga. She later served as Onondaga's dean of arts and sciences and vice president for academic affairs. She also has served as dean of the division of humanities and social sciences at Middlesex County College in Edison, N.J.

A native of the Philippines, Russell came to the United States in 1975 as an international student at Syracuse University, where she earned a master's degree in urban and regional planning and a Ph.D. in social sciences with a focus on economics and planning. She also holds a bachelor's degree and a master's degree in economics from the Philippines. Before coming to the U.S., she worked as an economist for the United Nations Development Programme in the Philippines.

Russell has received numerous awards, including a Fulbright Administrative Award to Germany in 1997. As a dean at Onondaga Community College, she received the Chancellor's Award for Excellence in Professional Service for the State University of New York in 1991 to participate in Harvard University's Management Development Program.

- Serving the Boca Raton campus of Palm Beach Community College since September 2007 as Provost.
- Completed at Syracuse University a Ph.D. in Economics from the Maxwell School of Citizenships. A Master's of Science in Urban and Regional Planning, from Syracuse University, which was the second master's degree, the other one was in Economics.
- Teaching economics was my initial passion, and continues to be a discipline of interest. Previously Dean at Marywood University, where I carried out my commitment to higher education and experience community engagement by promoting the interest of the university community.
- Interested in the economic development of the region.
- Interested in providing international experience to community college students and promote an understanding of global issues.
- Prior to that, all my higher education experience was devoted to community colleges. First as director of institutional research and planning, then as dean of arts and sciences (in two community colleges) and as an academic vice president covering 15 years of higher education experience. When Fulbright provided me an award to Germany, I lectured on the U.S community college system, visiting several universities and meeting with higher education administrators and faculty. State University of New York granted me the chancellor award in "professional excellence". Also I received through State University of New York a fellowship to go to Harvard University for its Management Development Program.
- Other professional job: economist for the United Nations Development Programme.

Members removed under this section shall not continue to serve until a new appointment is made and removal shall create a vacancy. Any vacancy shall be filled by the Board of County Commissioners.

Section 7. Ethics: Conflicts of Interest.

All advisory board members shall be governed by the applicable provisions of the Palm Beach County Ethics Ordinance upon its adoption. Abstention from voting due to a conflict of interest on more than three (3) separate matters during any calendar year shall result in automatic removal.

Section 8. Staff Support.

The Director of Public Affairs, the Cable Coordinator, and staff from County Channel 20 shall work closely with the advisory board and assist said board, as needed. The Director of Public Affairs or his/her designee shall be responsible for the preparation of the board's agenda and minutes. The Assistant County Attorney assigned to represent the Cable Television Division shall provide legal guidance as needed.

Section 9. Sunset.

This advisor board shall be reviewed three (3) years from the date of this esolution to determine whether to continue or dissolve the board. At least ninety (90) days prior to the scheduled review, the board shall submit a written recommendation

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to the Borra of County Commissioners as to w be continued or dissolved. If the board recommends continuation, recommendation the shall also include recommended revisions to this resolution.
