EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: (A) Accept on behalf of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office a Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) State Criminal Alien Assistance Program 0766 Grant in the amount of \$498,984; and (**B) Approve** a Budget Amendment of \$498,984 in the Sheriff's Grants Fund.

Summary: The Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) has made funds available to be used for correctional purposes. These funds, in accordance to the Department of Justice Reauthorization Act of 2005, will be used in one of the thirteen areas designated. Resultantly, the offset general fund dollars will be used to fund the Eagle Academy through the 2010 calendar year. There is no match requirement associated with this award. No additional positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. <u>Countywide</u> (DW)

Background and Justification: The Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA), Office of Justice Programs, U.S. Department of Justice, in conjunction with the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) provides federal funding to states and localities that incurred correctional officer salary costs for incarcerating undocumented criminal aliens who have at least one felony or two misdemeanor convictions for violations of state or local law, and who are incarcerated for at least 4 consecutive days during the reporting period. This program has assisted states and localities which have requested assistance in defraying the cost incurred for the imprisonment of undocumented criminal aliens, resulting in more than \$4 billion in funds being distributed to over 660 unique jurisdictions in the last 10 years. The Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) number is 16.606 and the contract number is 2010-AP-BX-0766.
