Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Three (3) Agreements under the FY 2010-2011 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) totaling \$291,207 in the amounts indicated below for the period October 1, 2010 to September 30, 2011:

- 1. Children's Place at Home Safe, Inc. in the amount of \$61,750;
- 2. Redlands Christian Migrant Association, Inc, in the amount of \$35,592; and,
- 3. City of Belle Glade in the amount of \$193,865.

Summary: The FY 2010-2011 Action Plan approved by the Board of County Commissioners on July 20, 2010, (R2010-1156) allocated \$1,356,450 of CDBG funds for the provision of public services, fair housing activities and housing activity delivery costs. The services to be provided by the three agencies under the contracts for which approval is being sought are as follows: Children's Place at Home Safe, Inc. will provide emergency/transitional residential care and shelter to ninety (90) abused and neglected children; Redlands Christian Migrant Association will operate one (1) child development center in the Glades region to serve one hundred ten (110) children of migrant farmworkers; and the City of Belle Glade for activity delivery cost associated with the implementation of six (6) CDBG funded housing rehabilitations and four (4) CDBG funded demolitions. HCD staff reviewed agency program budgets to ensure no duplication in reimbursement of expenses from other County programs. <u>These are Federal funds that require no local match.</u> (Countywide) (TKF)

Background and Justification: Palm Beach County Housing and Community Development (HCD) receives CDBG funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). On July 20, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved Document R2010-1156, "Palm Beach County Action Plan: October 2010-September 2011." The Plan contains a listing of the proposed CDBG projects for FY 2010-11, including twenty-two (22) activities involving the provision of public service and activity delivery costs. On October 19, 2010 the BCC approved eighteen (18) agreements that allocated \$997,991 of CDBG funds for public service projects and activity delivery costs. Approval of these three (3) agreements will allocate \$291,207 and the remaining agreement for \$67,252 will be brought forward to the BCC at a later date. The CDBG funding being requested for some of the activities will be used to pay salaries, however, based on HUD's recommendations to HCD, funding of salaries for public service activities are discouraged, therefore, these agreements are written to allow the county to reimburse the agencies for the provision of a quantifiable service to eligible beneficiaries.
