I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: A) ratify the signature of the Chair on a State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) Agreement No. CM016 Amendment No. 1; and B) receive and file a fully executed State of Florida Department of Environmental Protection Agreement No. CM016 Amendment No. 1 for a \$50,000 Florida Coastal Management Program grant approving a 6-month time extension, and modifying the scope of work.

Summary: On December 2, 2008, the Board authorized submission of a Florida Coastal Partnership Initiative grant application (R2008-2237) for upland improvements at the Zeke's Marina property. The grant was awarded, and on October 20, 2009, a Receive and File agenda item was presented to the Board to enter the Grant Agreement (R2009-1798) into public records and to establish budget for the grant. The Grant Agreement required all improvements to be completed by September 30, 2010; however, due to construction delays, the County requested a 6-month time extension and a modification to the scope of work reducing the proposed sidewalk width from 12 feet to 6 feet. The time extension and modification of the scope of work was approved by FDEP, and Commissioner Aaronson signed the Amendment on behalf of the County. The document is now being presented to the Board to receive and file. District 1 (AH)

Background and Justification: The Florida Coastal Partnership Initiative makes federal funds from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) available to local governments for the protection and effective management of Florida's coastal resources. The grant is administered by FDEP. The grant funds are being used at Zeke's Marina to clear exotic vegetation, plant native vegetation, install a picnic shelter, and construct a 6-foot wide multi-purpose path. Amendment No. 1 to the Grant Agreement provides for a 6-month time extension changing the end date from September 30, 2010, to March 31, 2011, and modifies the project scope to reduce the width of the proposed sidewalk from 12 feet to 6 feet in order to reduce the impact to archaeological resources on site.

DEP AGREEMENT NO. CM016 AMENDMENT NO. 1

THE DEP AGREEMENT No. CM016 entered into on the 1st day of September 2009, between the STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (hereinafter referred to as the "Department") and PALM BEACH COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS (hereinafter referred to as "Grantee") is hereby amended.

WHEREAS, the Grantee determines that it is necessary to extend the project period ending date to March 31, 2011 and amend the Scope of Work, Project Objectives and Related Tasks and Deliverables and Project Budget Narrative as shown in Attachment A to the original Agreement; and

Scope of Work Information

Zeke's Marina is a unique waterfront property located on Jupiter Inlet at the southern end of the Indian River Lagoon in Palm Beach County. The property was part of the DuBois pioneer homestead, site of the oldest structure in the County – a pineapple packing house. Restoration and development of Zeke's Marina is an appropriate way to provide for the needs of park patrons and to preserve the natural environment – the site is heavily covered in exotic vegetation and in need of park facilities. Palm Beach County will use FCMP funds to:

- 1) remove exotic species and replant using salt tolerant native vegetation in order to provide habitat for coastal species;
- 2) construct a 6'-wide paved multi-purpose path that will connect with the Jupiter Riverwalk that will link marinas, restaurants, natural areas, the DuBois Park and Loxahatchee River to the project site; and 3) install park facilities picnic shelters, tables and grills, bike racks and trash receptacles.

The County will provide non-federal matching funds towards this project from costs for exotic vegetation/native revegetation, park facilities and the multi-purpose path.

Objective 1: Restoration and development of Zeke's Marina

Task 1: Removal of exotic vegetation

Task 2: Plant salt tolerant native landscape, including a 1/3 acre native buffer along the western edge of the site.

Task 3: Construct a 6' wide paved multi-purpose path through the project site that will connect with the Jupiter Riverwalk.

Deliverables: Photos of before and after exotic species removal, salt tolerant native landscape and multipurpose path.

Project Budget Schedule: Type dollar amounts only in applicable categories (round to the nearest dollar; no cents) and leave other categories blank. If your grant Agreement requires match, it must equal the FCMP funds requested, or one hundred percent (100%). Prior written approval from the Department's Grant Manager shall be required for changes between budget categories up to 10% of the total budget. The DEP Grant Manager will transmit a copy of the written approval and revised budget to the DEP Contracts Disbursements Office for inclusion in the Agreement file. Changes greater than 10% will require a formal amendment to the Agreement.
