I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF
Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: (A) A Grant Adjustment Notice from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE), extending the expiration date from September 30, 201 to June 30, 2011 and (B) the 9 th amendment to the interlocal agreement (R2001-2131, dated 12/04/05 with the Office of the Public Defender for reentry services for \$193,500 from October 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011.
Summary: In 2008, a permanent re-entry task force was approved, and a formalized structure begat to take shape under the leadership of Carey Haughwout, and Harry Johnston. With this, re-entry became a permanent component of the Criminal Justice Commissions' crime prevention strategy. This project hopes to assist up to 200 persons who voluntarily agree to services. The various components of the project include; services to the County jail, services for a countywide paralegal and coordinator implement the strategic plan for reentry. There is no match requirement. Countywide (GB)
Background and Policy Issues: Since its inception, the Criminal Justice Commission has made Crim Prevention a priority. The continuation of this expenditure is requested to formalize and create a sour structure to link countywide services as highlighted in the Assessment of Re-Entry Services Reported in 2008. This assessment report highlighted the deficiencies in Palm Beach County re-ent services. Among the deficiencies noted in the report is a lack of countywide services similar to successful programs throughout the country and South Florida. These additional funding opportunities are an effect to create a seamless network of services for re-entry in Palm Beach County. The countywide effort we decrease duplication and focus the efforts strategically on items identified in a countywide strategic platfor re-entry services.
