Summary: Per Resolution No. R96-205, the AAAB consists of nine (9) members. Seven (7) members are District appointments (Seats 1 through 7) and two (2) members are At-Large appointments (Seats 8 & 9). On January, 11, 2011, the term for Seat No. 9 expires and is open for appointment of a three (3) year term as stipulated in the Resolution. Memos and forms dated December 1, 2010 were forwarded to the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) notifying the BCC of the expirations. The current incumbent, Mr. Ecclestone meets the membership requirements and is willing to serve another term. No other nominations were received.

A prohibited relationship waiver is being recommended for E. Llwyd Ecclestone, employee of the Ecclestone Organization, which has one (1) existing commercial lease with the Board of County Commissioners. Mr. Ecclestone has disclosed this relationship and is requesting a waiver pursuant to Section 2.443(d) of the Code of Ethics. The waiver is being recommended based on staff's determination that the contract between E. Llwyd Ecclestone and the County constitutes no conflict of interest with his duties on the AAAB. <u>Countywide</u> (AH)

Background and Justification: The AAAB, created December 18, 1984, is charged with the duty of giving recommendations and advice to the BCC concerning the planning, development, construction, reconstruction, operation and financial viability of the airports and aviation activities coming within the purview of the BCC. The AAAB continues to actively participate in Department of Airports matters. The AAAB has nine (9) members; nine (9) white males.

E. Llwyd Ecclestone has been a driving force in Palm Beach County's development for more than 40 years. He is a visionary whose contributions to South Florida's growth are unmatched.

After graduating from the prestigious Taft School he attended Brown University and graduated from Michigan's Wayne State University with a degree in Business Administration.

Growing up in Grosse Pointe, Mr. Ecclestone's talent as a developer became evident early in his career, beginning with his first foray into the construction business in 1962 as part owner of the Hillock-Ecclestone Company. Within a year, Mr. Ecclestone had purchased his partner's interest in the company, which then became the Ecclestone Construction Company. Having seen the great possibilities of the downtown Detroit urban renewal area called Lafayette Park, Mr. Ecclestone developed and built Cherboneau Place co-op with the Detroit Teachers Association and then, across the street, Cherboneau North—the first condominium in Michigan. After his success in Lafayette Park, Ecclestone also began building custom homes and other specialized commercial buildings on a design-and-build basis. He went on to form the Michigan Realty Company, which purchased apartment buildings, refurbished and sold them under the condominium form of ownership, a new concept in the early 1960's, now commonly known as condo conversion.

In 1965, Mr. Ecclestone was called to Florida to join the Lost Tree Village Corporation. He was responsible for home construction, land development and property sales in the growth of Lost Tree Village, an exquisite 450-acre private golf community on the coast of Palm Beach County. After three years with Lost Tree Village Corporation, Mr. Ecclestone decided to make Florida his permanent home, a move that would eventually change the face of Palm Beach County. He sold his businesses in Michigan and organized National Investment Company and its subsidiaries that went on to create such successful properties as the Forum III Office Complex, Plaza Centre, Old Port Cove, Lost Tree Village South, Ocean House Condominiums and custom built homes in Lost Tree Village.

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One of Mr. Ecclestone's most notable achievements began in 1976 when he signed an agreement with PGA of America to build both their Administrative and Golfing Headquarters in Palm Beach County. He subsequently purchased 2,000 acres from John D. MacArthur's Bankers Life and Casualty Company to build PGA National community in the City of Palm Beach Gardens.

For the next 25 years under Mr. Ecclestone's direction, the PGA National development project was completed. The project includes 5,300 homes, four PGA National golf courses operated under the PGA National Golf Club with 2,000 members, the 339-room PGA National Resort and Spa and Shoppes on the Green in a 140,000 square foot shopping center on PGA Boulevard. The entire project has been built out and the PGA National Resort and Spa and its golf courses were sold in January 2007. Subsequently, Mr. Ecclestone acquired a 70% controlling interest in seven Hilton/Doubletree branded hotels throughout the country and plays an active role in long range planning and marketing goals.

Additionally, Ecclestone and his companies developed, built and own the Regions Financial Tower, a 15-story office building in West Palm Beach, Lake Crystal, a 640-unit apartment complex in West Palm Beach, which recently sold and Willow Lake, a 220-unit apartment complex in Lake Worth, which also was recently sold.

In 2003, Ecclestone embarked on developing and owning college student housing projects, the first of which was a 924-bedroom community in Morgantown, West Virginia called The District. Recently, City approvals were received to commence with a 940-bed student housing project, complete with a 750-car parking garage, in Norfolk, Virginia.

Mr. Ecclestone's influence is not limited to the world of real estate. He is a Director of the Palm Beach County Aviation and Airports Advisory Board, the Palm Beach Civic Association and the Economic Council of Palm Beach County, an organization of which he is also a past Chairman. He is the Chairman of the Shore Protection Board of the Town of Palm Beach. He is a member of the Urban Land Institute, The Chief Executives Organization, Council of 100 and the World Presidents Organization. Mr. Ecclestone was also the Chair of Airport '88, the committee responsible for the opening of Palm Beach International Airport. In the past he was involved as a Director of Discover Palm Beach County, The Land Preservation Trust of Palm Beach County, First Marine Banks, Inc., Chamber of Commerce of the Palm Beaches, and The Better Business Bureau, Inc. Moreover, Mr. Ecclestone has lent his expertise to many organizations as a Board Member, including the Florida Housing Finance Authority, St. Mary's Medical Center, and the Commission on Ethics for the State of Florida.

Ever aware of those less fortunate than himself, Mr. Ecclestone is also involved in many philanthropic activities. He was a Co-chair of the campaign that created Home Safe of Palm Beach County, an agency dedicated to the protection of abused children. He is a Life-Director of the Raymond F. Kravis Center for the Performing Arts, and a past Director of YMCA of the Palm Beaches. He and his wife, Diana, are active supporters of the Peggy Adams Animal Rescue League, Columbia University Hospital, Palm Beach Zoo, Royal Poinciana Chapel and numerous other charitable organizations and institutions.

Mr. Ecclestone's many accomplishments, along with his determination and commitment, have been recognized in several areas. Northwood University honored him in 1989 as an Outstanding Business Leader and in 1992 bestowed upon him an honorary Doctor of Laws degree for his meaningful contributions to society. He was distinguished by the Homebuilders Contractors Association of Palm Beach County with an Achievement Award and the Elmer Hedrick Award for Excellence in the Building Industry. He was also the second recipient of the Palm Beach Post's John D. MacArthur Business Leader of the Year Award, and most recently was named a Business Hall of Fame Laureate presented by Junior Achievement.

I. AUTHORITY :

Resolution No. R-84-1960, adopted December 17, 1984; amended by Resolution No. R-90-1992, amended by Resolution No. R-92-1808, adopted on December 1, 1992; amended and superseded by Resolution No. R-93-615, adopted on May 18, 1993; amended and superseded by Resolution No. R-96-205, adopted on February 20, 1996.

III. COMPOSITION, QUALIFICATIONS, TERMS & REMOVAL :

The Committee shall be composed of nine (9) members: one (1) member to be appointed to each district with the remaining members appointed at-large. Members shall possess a favorable reputation for experience in at least one (1) of the following areas: architecture, engineering, banking, insurance, law, accounting, non-residential construction, business and consumer. District appointments shall carry a special requirement of possessing "substantial, prior, verifiable experience in aviation or airports". After the initial term of office, all members shall be appointed or reappointed for a three (3) year term. The BCC shall have the authority to remove any member for cause upon written charges and after a public hearing. Members shall serve without compensation.

EXTENDED COMPOSITION :

IV. MEETINGS :

The Advisory Board may meet in regular session monthly, or as required, at times and places set by the Advisory Board or as determined by the Chairman.

V. FUNCTIONS :

To make recommendations and advise the BCC regarding planning, development, construction, operation and financial viability of airports and aviation activities coming within the purview of the BCC.
