**FIRST AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**

**THIS FIRST AMENDMENT** to Contract R2009-0646, dated April 21, 2009, is made as of \_\_\_\_\_, by and between Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, by and through its Board of County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as the County, and Intellitech Corporation, an Ohio Corporation authorized to do business in the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as Consultant.

In consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the County and Consultant agree as follows:

1. The term of Contract R2009-0646, set to expire on February 11, 2011 shall be extended to October 31, 2011.

2. Addition of the following language:

Pursuant to Ordinance R2009-049, as amended, Palm Beach County's Inspector General is authorized to review past, present and proposed County contracts, transactions, accounts and records. The Inspector General's authority includes, but is not limited to, the power to audit, investigate, monitor and inspect the activities of entities contracting with the County, or anyone acting on their behalf, in order to ensure compliance with contract requirements and to detect corruption and fraud.

3. All other terms of Contract R2009-0646 remain unmodified and in full force and effect.






