NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants set forth in the GRANT AGREEMENT and in this AMENDMENT, HUD and Palm Beach County agree that the GRANT AGREEMENT is now amended to include the following provision, effective as of October 7, 2010.

The Grantee shall comply with requirements established by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) concerning the Dun and Bradstreet Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS), the Central Contractor Registration (CCR) database, and the Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act, as set forth in Appendix A to Part 25—Award Term, Financial Assistance Use of Universal Identifier and Central Contractor Registration, 75 Fed. Reg. 55671 (Sept. 14, 2010) (to be codified at 2 CFR part 25), and Appendix A to Part 170—Award Term, Requirements for Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act Implementation, 75 Fed. Reg. 55663 (Sept. 14, 2010) (to be codified at 2 CFR part 170).
