I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: Resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida pursuant to Palm Beach County Code Chapter 13, Article II, Emergency Medical Services, Division I (Ordinance No. 2010-056); granting a three (3) year extension of existing emergency medical services Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for Medics Ambulance Service, Inc. and Atlantic/Palm Beach Ambulance, Inc., doing business as American Medical Response to December 31, 2014.

Summary: These Resolutions implement, by the extension of the existing ambulance Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity, agreements between the private ambulance services and Palm Beach County to allow Palm Beach County Fire-Rescue to provide transportation of patients from the scene of 9-1-1 calls instead of the private ambulance providers. In anticipation of Palm Beach County Fire Rescue COPCN renewal on December 31, 2010, and as a result of agreements with the private providers, Fire - Rescue will provide all emergency response and patient transportation services in all of their services areas. The private ambulance providers are requesting the issuance of a three (3) year extension of their current Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (COPCN) from January 1, 2011 to December 31, 2014. Private Providers will serve as a secondary provider for Advanced Life Support emergency transport, which will allow them to provide daily back up during the pilot program and be available for response in the event of storms, evacuations and disasters. It will also allow for emergency and non-emergency inter-facility transfers. The EMS Council approves granting the 3 year extension. Countywide (DW)

Background and Policy Issues: Palm Beach County Fire-Rescue is currently limited to providing patient transportation only to those patients needing advanced life support services. In 2005, the Board discussed increasing that service to all patients, including those needing basic life support services or first aid. The Board directed Fire-Rescue staff to work with both the private providers and the firefighters' union representatives to develop a plan of transition. Based on the previous Board Direction to be effective January 1, 2011 it is recommended that Palm Beach County Fire Rescue expand the existing pilot program for BLS Transport to include the entire unincorporated area of Palm Beach County and those municipalities that have contracted for service or are in a Fire-Rescue MSTU. The representatives of each area have agreed to a plan that is incorporated in the ordinance changes. Under the plan, effective upon passage of the ordinance, Fire-Rescue will service the entire unincorporated area of Palm Beach County and those municipalities that have contracted for service or are in a Fire-Rescue MSTU. The private providers want a three (3) year extension of their current COPCN's in order to assure their continued service with inter-facility transportations.
