# I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: donation of a VHF antennae and 200 feet of a 7/8<sup>th</sup> inch transmission cable (Equipment) to the Jupiter-Tequesta Repeater Group, Inc. (JTRG), a Florida non-profit corporation.

Summary: On December 20, 2010, JTRG requested that the County return to JTRG the Equipment located on the radio communications tower (Tower) at the former Fire Station No. 14 in Jupiter Farms Park, which is slated to be removed from the Tower in conjunction with the County's microwave upgrade project. Upon investigation, Staff determined that in 1989, the County installed the original Equipment that JTRG claims ownership of; however, the County has been unable to verify whether the original Equipment was subsequently replaced by JTRG. Staff has confirmed that the Equipment has never been used for County purposes and is not maintained by the County. Furthermore, the County has no current or future use for the Equipment. Staff was able to price the replacement cost of the Equipment as if it were purchased in 2002/2003 at \$1,647.30. Since the original Equipment was purchased prior to 2002/2003 and based upon ordinary wear and tear and the depreciation, Staff has determined that the Equipment currently has no commercial value. In light of the circumstances, Staff recommends that the County remove the Equipment from the Tower at the time that the County begins its microwave system upgrade project and donate it to JTRG in its "as is" condition. If the Board approves this donation, FDO Staff will complete the necessary paperwork to dispose of this asset at the time of transfer to JTRG. In the event of damage or loss to the Equipment prior to the transfer, the County will have no obligations to JTRG, as JTRG has been unable to provide the County with evidence of title to the Equipment. **Background and Justification:** On December 20, 2010, JTRG requested that the County return to JTRG the Equipment located on the radio communications tower (Tower) at the former Fire Station No. 14 in Jupiter Farms Park, which is slated to be removed from the Tower in conjunction with the County's microwave upgrade project. The Tower is located at 16749 Jupiter Farms Road.

THE JUPITER TEQUESTA REPEATER GROUP APPRECIATES YOUR INQUIRY AND RESPONSE IN REGARDS TO THE USE OF THE OLD FIRE STATION #14 TOWER FOR A RECONNECT OF A BACK UP EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS AMATEUR RADIO REPEATER. AS I PREVIOUSLY STATED IN THE REQUEST DATED SEPTEMBER 22, 2010 WE MOVED OUR MAIN REPEATER FROM THE SITE AT THE OLD FIRE STATION #14 TO A SITE IN HOBE SOUND.

AT THE OLD FIRE STATION #14 THE JUPITER TEQUESTA REPEATER GROUP (JTRG) STILL HAS ON THE TOWER OVER 200 FEET OF COAXIAL CABLE, AN ANTENNA SPECIALIST 2 METER FIBERGLASS ANTENNA, SUPPORT BRACKETS FOR THE ANTENNA, CONNECTIONS, POLYPHAZERS, GROUNDING BRACKETS AND HANGERS WHICH WE OWN AND IS THE PROPERTY OF THE JUPITER TEQUESTA REPEATER GROUP INC. TO CLEAR UP ANY MISUNDERSTANDINGS ALL WE WERE ASKING FOR WAS TO CONNECT THE RADIO/REPEATER TO OUR EQUIPMENT/ANTENNA CURRENTLY ON THE TOWER. THIS REQUEST IS IN NO COMPARISON TO THE REQUEST BY LOGGERS RUN COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION.

IN YOUR RESPONSE LETTER DATED OCTOBER 5<sup>TH</sup>, 2010 "UNFORTUNATELY, STAFF DOES NOT SUPPORT THE PLACEMENT OF YOUR EQUIPMENT ON THIS TOWER FOR REASONS STATED IN HER RESPONSE" RE: AUDREY WOLF.

IT IS ALSO UNFORTUNATE FOR OUR COMMUNITY NOT TO HAVE A BACK UP EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS REPEATER AT THAT SITE WHICH WAS EXTREMELY USEFULL AND BENEFICIAL DURING OUR PREVIOUS HURRICANES WHEN THE COUNTY EQUIPMENT FAILED.

OUR EQUIPMENT IS CURRENTLY ON THE TOWER AT THE OLD FIRE STATION #14AND BEING THAT OUR REQUEST TO RECONNECT HAS BEEN DENIED, WE NOW REQUEST OUR EQUIPMENT TO BE RETURNED TO THE OWNERS AND PURCHASERS OF SAID EQUIPMENT TO ITS OWNER, THE JUPITER TEQUESTA REPEATER GROUP UPON REMOVAL FROM THE TOWER.

#### IN SUMMERY;

THE JUPITER TEQUESTA REPEATER GROUP OWNS THE HAM RADIO EQUIPMENT CURRENTLY ON THE FOWER AT THE OLD FIRE STATION #14. THE JUPITER TEQUESTA REPEATER GROUP HAS BEEN DENIED OUR REPEATER RECONNECT. WE ARE REQUESTING OUR EQUIPMENT BACK WHEN IT IS REMOVED FROM THE TOWER.
