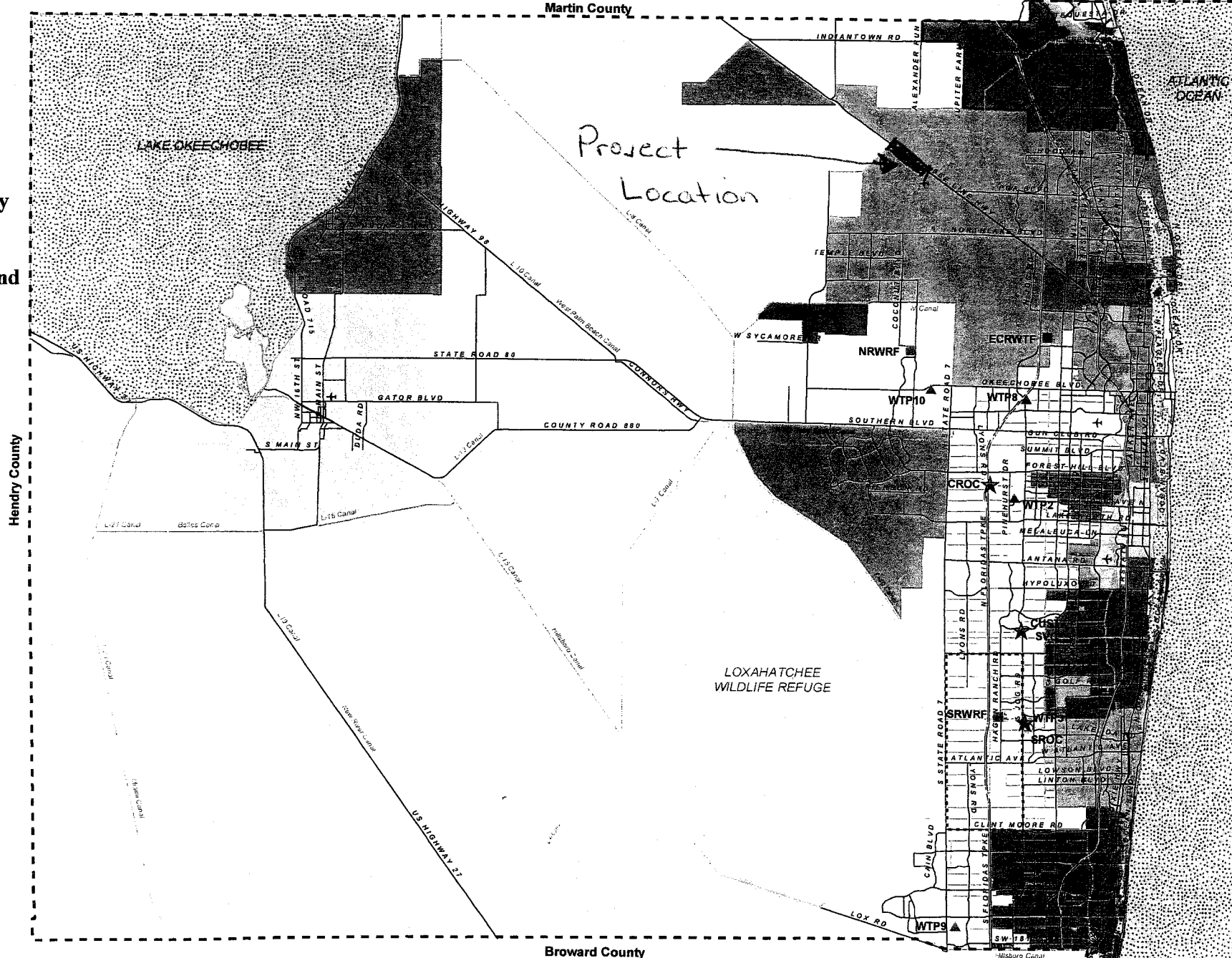

SCOPE OF WORK FOR

Water and Sewer Service to North County General Aviation Airport

INTRODUCTION

Palm Beach County (County) entered into a Contract for Construction Services date September 14, 2010 (Resolution/Document R2010-1422), by and between Palm Beach County and AKA Services, Inc., for the Construction Services of this Authorization.

This Contract for Construction Services encompasses providing services related to installation of the potable water mains and services and force mains to The North County General Aviation Airport.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Contractor shall provide and install 10,920 lineal feet of 12" PVC potable water main, 25 lf of 8" PVC, 250 lf of DIP potable water main, 320 lf potable water main, 8 fire hydrants, 3 connections to existing potable water main, 11,092 lf of 6" PVC force main, 2,028 lf of 4" PVC force main, and connection to existing force mains. All potable water mains, and force mains shall be constructed in accordance with Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department Minimum Engineering and Construction Standards, as indicated in the construction plans and contract documents.

COMPENSATION

Compensation shall be based on the Contract for Construction Services dated September 14, 2010 (Resolution/Document R2010-1422) as approved by the Board of County Commissioners.

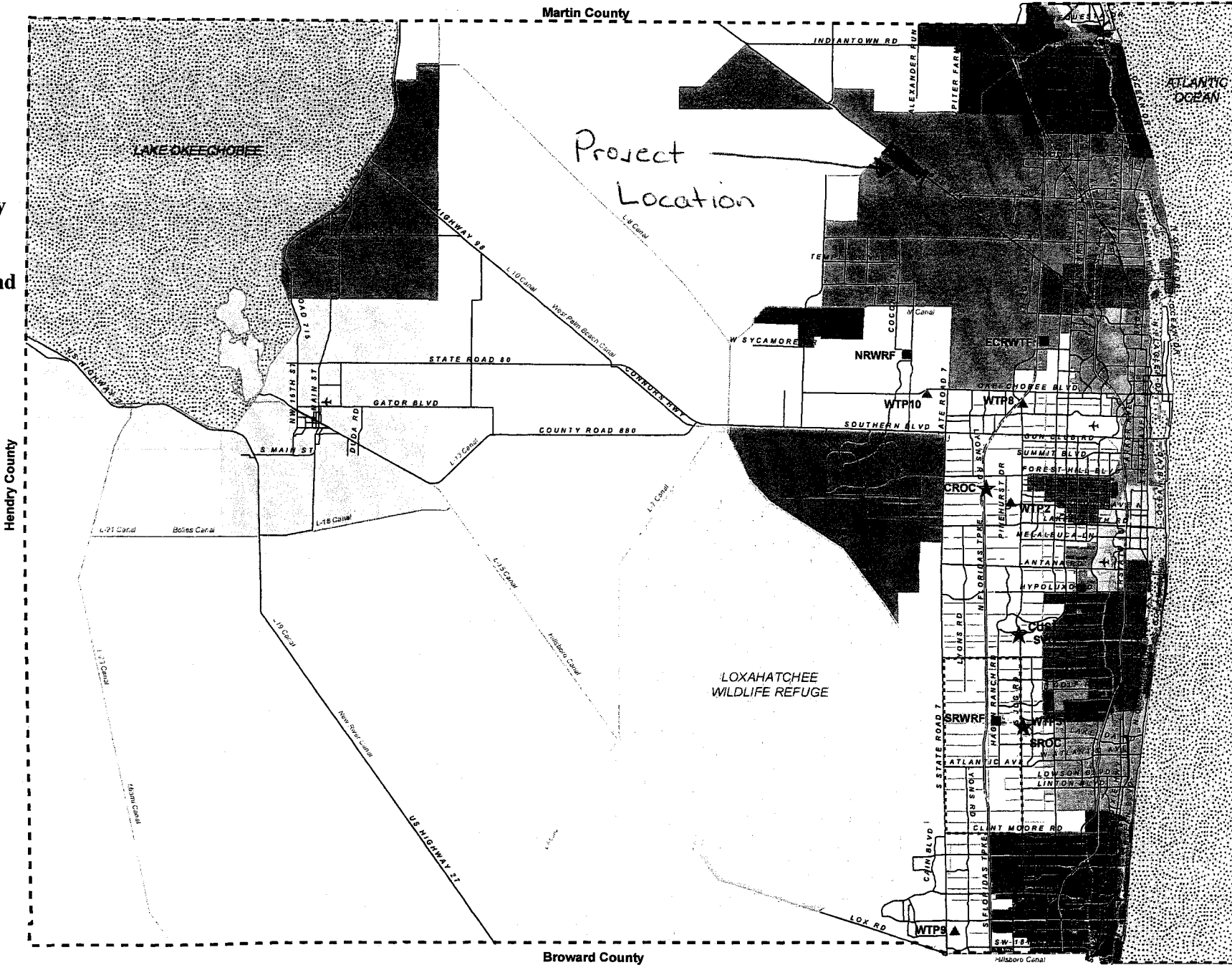

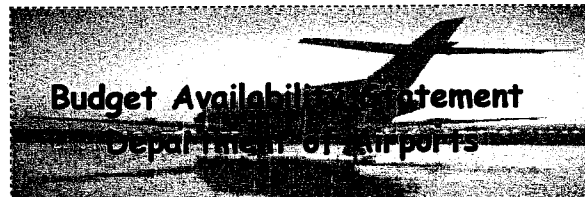
