I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to adopt: a Resolution by the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida, authorizing the Economic Development Office to submit a Section 108 Loan Fund Application for \$10,000,000 to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); authorizing acceptance of the funds awarded in order to assist established businesses in Palm Beach County; authorizing the County Administrator or his designee to execute the Loan Application documents in order to implement the Palm Beach County Section 108 Loan Program and issue debt obligations pursuant thereto.

Summary: This Application will increase the allocation of federal funds from HUD by \$10,000,000, enable Palm Beach County to continue offering funding to businesses as a way of creating economic vitality and new jobs in the County area and ensure the continuity of the Program. The current loan fund balance of \$5,365,000 is expected to be disbursed in less than one year to eligible business projects currently being considered for approval and are under revision. The Palm Beach County Section 108 Program was developed to create a source of loan funding for use by businesses, investors, community and non-profit organizations, and economic development organizations to implement business ventures that will create new jobs and help revitalize communities. To date, 586 jobs have been created with a total investment of \$38,392,388. No County funds will be pledged to complete any project funded by a Section 108 loan. These are Federal funds that do not require local match. Countywide (DW)

Background and Justification: On January 30, 2009, HUD submitted a Letter of Approval for a \$13,340,000 loan fund, for a period of five (5) years, which is to expire on September 30, 2014. <u>Section 108 Loan Program</u>: On March 12, 2002 (Agenda Item # 6D-1), the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved policies for the development and administration of a revolving loan program funded by HUD under the CDBG Section 108 Loan Guarantee Program. On June 18, 2002 (Documents R2002-0989 and R2002-0990), the BCC approved the first amendment to the Palm Beach County Five-Year Consolidated Plan to incorporate the Section 108 Loan Guarantee Program and the application for 108 funds for \$15,000,000. HUD approved the County's application for funding on September 26, 2002.

RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, **AUTHORIZING** THE ECONOMIC **DEVELOPMENT OFFICE TO SUBMIT A SECTION 108** LOAN FUND APPLICATION FOR \$10,000,000 TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD); AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF THE FUNDS AWARDED IN ORDER TO ASSIST ESTABLISHED BUSINESSES IN PALM BEACH **COUNTY; AUTHORIZING** THE COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE LOAN APPLICATION DOCUMENTS IN ORDER TO **IMPLEMENT THE PALM BEACH COUNTY SECTION 108** LOAN PROGRAM AND ISSUE DEBT OBLIGATIONS PURSUANT THERETO.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida believes that it is appropriate to utilize all available resources to facilitate economic growth in Palm Beach County and desires to obtain financial assistance from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), under Section 108 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, for the purpose of providing gap financial assistance to established businesses in Palm Beach County, through the County's Section 108 Loan Program; and

WHEREAS, Revolving Loan Fund programs authorized under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, and as provided in the regulations thereunder, 24 CFR 570 (the CDBG Regulations), including the Section 108 Loan Guarantee Program provided under Subpart M, 24 CFR 570.700 – 570.710 of the CDBG Regulations, have as their primary objective the development of viable urban communities by, among other things, providing expanded economic opportunities for persons of low and moderate income; and

WHEREAS, HUD is authorized, pursuant to the Section 108 Program and the CDBG Regulations to guarantee loans to the County for the provision of assistance, where necessary and appropriate, to carry out economic development projects which meet the national objectives of eliminating slums or blight, or providing job opportunities to persons of low and moderate income, or providing for an urgent need as defined by HUD; and

WHEREAS, in Section 290.0411, Florida Statutes, the Florida Legislature declared that providing expanded economic opportunities for persons of low to moderate income is a State objective and that those community development activities which expand economic opportunities by providing direct benefit to persons of low and moderate income are public purposes for which public money may be borrowed, expended, loaned, and granted; and

WHEREAS, in Section 125.045, Florida Statutes, the Florida Legislature declared that the use of public funds towards the achievement of enhancing and

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expanding economic activity in the counties of the State by attracting and retaining business enterprises conducive to economic promotion, enhancing and preserving purchasing power and employment opportunities for State residents, and improving the welfare and competitive position of the State constitutes a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach Board of County Commissioners has determined that the use of public funds to assist in implementing the Palm Beach County Section 108 Loan Program constitutes a public purpose as described in Section 290.0411 and Section 125.045 of the Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section I. The forgoing recitals are true and correct and are expressly incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.

Section II. The Economic Development Office is authorized to submit to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) a Section 108 Loan Application for \$10,000,000 to continue lending under the established Palm Beach County Section 108 Loan Program.

Section III. The County Administrator or his Designee is authorized to execute all documents related to this Section 108 loan application in order to implement the Palm Beach County Section 108 Loan Program and issue debt obligations pursuant hereto and to provide additional information as may be required.
