I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- A) A Contract with Community Asphalt Corp. (Community), in the amount of \$3,887,306.04 for the construction of Northlake Boulevard over the Loxahatchee Slough (Project) subject to receipt of Florida Department of Environmental Protection (State) funds for the total cost of the Project and a Waiver and Release from Community; and B) Change Order No. 1 to deduct the amount of \$499,975 from the contract with Community Asphalt Corp. (Community) for the construction of Northlake Boulevard over the Loxahatchee Slough (Project).

SUMMARY: Approval of this contract will allow Palm Beach County (County) to issue a Notice to Proceed to Community, a Palm Beach County company, to begin construction of the Project subject to the State releasing funds to cover the total cost of the Project. Community waives and releases any claims it has or could have against the County in the event the State fails to release the funds and the contract must be cancelled. The County's Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for the Project is 15% overall. The SBE participation committed for the Project by Community is 23.31%. Approval of Change Order No. 1 will allow for deletion of the City of West Palm Beach (City) utility work, at the City's request.

District 6 (MRE)

Background and Justification: Bids for the Project were received by the Engineering Department on November 18, 2010. Community was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. The Office of Small Business Assistance issued its evaluation on December 9, 2010. Time to complete the Project under this contract shall be no more than 550 calendar days. After the bidding process was complete, the City of West Palm Beach informed the County that they no longer wished to proceed with their proposed utility relocations, and that work is being deleted from Community's contract via Change Order No. 1. A Waiver and Release of Claim has been provided by Community protecting the County from any claim that may arise in the event the State fails to release the funds for the Project after this conditional award of the contract, but prior to issuance of the Notice to Proceed, and the Project is cancelled. Community has also provided a letter to the County stating that they have no objection to a 60 day extension for General Provisions Section 3-2.1 (time from bid opening to award).

WITNESSETH: The party of the second part agrees with the said party of the first part, for the consideration herein mentioned at his, its or their own proper cost and expense to do all the work and furnish all necessary labor, materials, equipment, machinery, tools, apparatus, services, state workmen's compensation and unemployment compensation taxes incurred in the performance of the contract, and means of transportation for the complete construction of:

in Palm Beach County, Florida, in the manner and to the full extent as set forth in the Contract Documents therefore and the Contract Documents relative thereto, are made a part of this Agreement as completely as if set forth herein, to the satisfaction of the party of the first part, or its duly authorized representative.

The said party of the second part further agrees for the consideration herein mentioned to commence the work with adequate forces and equipment within fourteen (14) calendar days of the date set forth in the "Notice to Proceed". The time limit for the completion of all work under this contract shall be five hundred fifty (550) calendar days. The date fixing this period upon the calendar shall be established and stated in the "Notice to Proceed". After commencement of the work, it shall be properly dispatched toward completion, to the satisfaction of the Engineer, and shall be fully completed within the time limit. It is understood and agreed that the time limit for completion of said work is the essence of the contract and should the contractor fail to complete the work within the time limit, it is agreed that for such calendar day that any work provided for in these Contract Documents shall remain incomplete after the time limit has expired, including any official extension of the time limit; the sum per day given in the contained schedules shall be deducted from monies due the Contractor, not as a penalty, but as liquidated (in accordance with Section 8-10.2 of the General Provisions) damages and added expense for supervision.

The Contractor shall take into account all contingent work which has to be done by other parties arising from any cause whatsoever, and shall not plead his want of knowledge of such contingent work as an excuse for delay in his work, or for its non-performance.

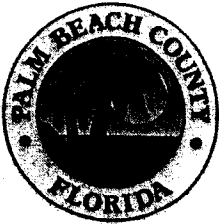

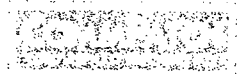

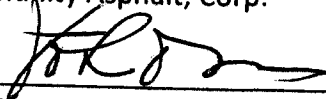
Whereas, Governor Rick Scott has issued a moratorium on the disbursement of State funds pending review; and

Whereas, the Project is completely dependent on State funds, without which the County will be unable to construct the Project; and

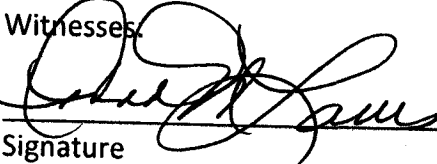

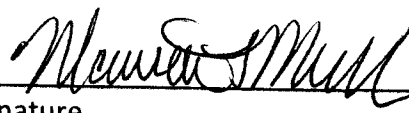
