EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Ι.

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: a Budget Transfer of \$86,500 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF) to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO).

Summary: Florida Statute 932.7055 requires that no less than 15% of the LETF's previous year's revenues be used for the support or operation of drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood and school resource officer programs of various non-profit organizations. The PBSO's FY 2011 estimated donation requirement is \$98,015. The funds are requested to aid qualified organizations that meet the requirements set forth in F.S. 932.7055. The PBSO's support of these programs exemplifies its strong commitment to the prevention and reduction of crime throughout the communities it serves and its desire to put money back into these communities to support organizations that provide such services. The current State LETF balance is \$1,781,799. Approval of this request will reduce the State Law Enforcement Trust Fund balance to \$1,695,299. The year-to-date transfer for all donations after approval of this item is \$1,286,996. The PBSO certifies that the use of these funds is in accordance with F.S. 932.7055. Below is a table indicating the organizations the PBSO seeks to fund and the corresponding amount of funding proposed per respective agency. This Statute requires that no less than 15 % of the last fiscal year's revenues be donated or expended for the support or operation of drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood or school resource officer programs. The PBSO certifies that the use of these funds is in accordance with F.S. 932.7055.

The Child Safety Education/Anti-Bullying Program provides vital education to children who otherwise might not receive this safety education and bullying aversion instruction. School teachers deliver the program to children ages 5-14 in collaboration with existing Parks and Recreation Department summer camp locations, Boys & Girls Clubs, and YMCAs.

4. What results are you committed to achieving? _

As calls from law enforcement to the A Child Is Missing Alert Program continue to increase, so, too, new forms of danger to children increase. It used to be that "stranger danger" was an effective way to teach children to be safe, but we now know significant harm can be done to children by people with whom the child's family is familiar. This scenario has resulted in the need to update current information and construct new, more effective, information in its place. That is the primary purpose of the Child Safety Education Program. The development and successful rollout in 2009 of the Bully Squad Program has addressed the epidemic issue of bullying among youth.



3. Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded: _____ The Girl Scouts of Southeast Florida will provide Power Up! Anti-Bullying series where in a 6 session program girls examine their own behavior as it relates to being a victim, bystander or bullier in a variety of settings including peer, group, home and school. Palm Beach County school district had reported that 2,032 acts of bullying occurred during the 2007-2008 school year, a staggering number that only increased to 2,286 incidents during school year 2008-2009. This series will help girls identify behaviors and learn appropriate steps to take to safely address a given situation. The program will be provided to underserved girls in Palm Beach County. Girl Scouts believe that all girls have a right to life free from violence, whether in their relationships at home, school or communities. Research from the U.S. Department of Education has shown that bullying can lead to terrible problems for bullies, victims and bystanders; studies have shown that it is by no means childhood inevitability. Girl Scouts of Southeast Florida plans to serve 140 girls through (4) 6 week workshops. Our trained facilitators will use discussion, games and other activities to work with girls on how to identify and address issues that compromise their safety.

Salaries (list employees and individual compensation): The Program Director will be employed on a parttime basis and will be paid \$12,000 annually.

There will be two program assistants earning \$8,400 each, also a driver who will perform premises maintenance and will be paid \$7500.00. All employees are hired on a part-time basis. A 20% estimated cost is assigned to benefits, which is in keeping with current Benefits packages in Florida. This benefit includes taxes and other health/medical expenses that will be paid on behalf of the employees.

Professional Fees (list vendor and type of service provided): Professional audit will be done by a team of certified auditors, Gruber and Associates, CPA will do the accounting and a local law firm will be retained for legal services.

Occupancy/Utilities (list utilities): The lease is \$120,000 and \$12,000 is earmarked for FP&L electricity. We also rent buildings for our annual Mother's Day and Father's Day recognition dinners. These are two events when the students recognize their parents with tributes as well as interact with each other in a semi-formal environment.

Printing & Publications (list type of material):Printing of the training material accounts for a large amount of our work. Our students work is also organized and bound to serve as proof and oftentimes to show and track their progress in the program. We also print certificates of recognition for our monthly recognition programs.

We also take them to the Kennedy Space Center, Law Enforcement Memorial Museum and Cape Canaveral as rewards for good grades and conduct. We also take field trips to Lion Country Safari,

Dreher Park Zoo, Flagler Museum and several trips to Gumbo Limbo Nature Center as incentives. We do not have a bus therefore, we rent vans for these trips. One chaperone to seven students travel with the students.

Meetings (attendees, purpose, items needed for meeting): <u>The staff attends professional training</u> seminars and notebooks are needed for note taking. However, the students and parents attend mandatory weekly seminars at the Drug Abuse Foundation headquarters where they participate in a variety of training sessions.

We strive to provide a nurturing, positive atmosphere where each student is encouraged to reach their full potential. One of our staff who is certified teaches the drug and alcohol classes. Incorporating her Drug, Alcohol, Traffic Awareness along with planting the seed of abusing prescription drugs with the visual use of "Painfully Obvious" has been effective. We implemented *Life Inside* a curriculum from the Tallahassee Correctional Department. This teaches our students the results of drug usage, crime and the reality of their choices.
