I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to:

A) ratify the Vice-Chairperson's signature on the application to the State of Florida Department of Education (DOE) for participation in the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) for the period of June 6, 2011, through August 19, 2011, in an amount not to exceed \$536,862 to provide nutritious meals for children; and

B) delegate authority to the County Administrator or his designee to sign additional State of Florida Department of Education (DOE) amendments and/or documents.

Summary: The SFSP funds nutritious meals for children 18 years and younger during the summer months. Approximately 90 sites have been identified across the County to serve these meals. Funding allows for maximum daily meal servings consisting of 2,170 breakfasts, 4,757 lunches and 2,722 snacks. The emergency signature process was used because there was not sufficient time to submit through the regular agenda process and meet the May 13, 2011 submission deadline. No County funds are required. (Human Services) <u>Countywide</u> (TKF)

Background and Justification: The Division of Human Services has participated in the SFSP for the past 20 years. SFSP was established to ensure that all children age 18 and under receive nutritious meals during the summer that are comparable to those served under the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs. Free meals are provided to all children at approved SFSP sites. The Division of Human Services is a Sponsor of the program operating under the authority of the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the State of Florida Department of Education (DOE). The Division, as the sponsor, will monitor sites for quality and compliance using nine (9) temporary positions, with salaries and mileage paid through Administrative grant funds from the SFSP.

This grant is being submitted in response to the 2011 Florida Department of Education Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) Application. The Division of Human Services has participated in the SFSP for the past nineteen years. The Division is applying for funds to provide nutritious meals to children 18 years and younger during the summer months. There are approximately 90 sites identified across the County with a maximum daily rate of meals served established at 2,170 breakfasts, 4,757 lunches and 2,722 snacks.

The Division will monitor the sites for quality and compliance with regulations using nine temporary positions. No County funds are required this year. The grant application is due to Florida Department of Education in Tallahassee on Friday, May 13, 2011. The Division is anticipating a maximum of \$536,862 in revenue from the Florida Department of Education to serve meals for the period of June 6, 2011 through August 19, 2011.

The complete application will be placed on the next agenda item for ratification.

 E. This Agreement may be renewed annually by the Department and the Sponsor by mutual agreement in writing. Renewal will be contingent on the Sponsor meeting program requirements in this Agreement and those outlined in part 225 of the Code of Federal Regulations and other pertinent instructions from the Department or the United States Department of Agriculture and shall pertain to programs under Sponsor's jurisdiction that have submitted annual applications and said applications have been given Department approval. F. This Agreement may be terminated upon 15 days written notice on the part of either party hereunto, and the Department may terminate this Agreement immediately after receipt of evidence that the terms and conditions of this Agreement and of the regulations governing the program have not been fully complied with by the Sponsor. Any termination of this Agreement by the Department shall be in accord with applicable laws and regulations. No termination or expiration of this Agreement, however, shall affect the obligations of this Agreement for noncompliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 shall be in accordance with applicable laws and regulations. 	 G. The Department may take such action, including prosecution for fraud under applicable state and federal statutes or initiate a reclaim, if any part of the money received by the Sponsor, through improper or negligent action, is diminished, lost, misapplied, or diverted from the program. This liability on the part of the Sponsor shall remain in effect for the applicable periods or limitations as called for by law after the effective date of termination of the Agreement. H. The Department shall inform the Sponsor of its right to request a review of decisions made by the Department which affect the participation of a sponsor in the program or the Sponsor's claim for reimbursement. It is understood and agreed by and between the Department and the Sponsor, whether public or private, that the regulations of the United States Department of Agriculture relating to the Food and Nutrition Services, Regulation number 225, attached, are made a part of this Agreement and that the Department, Sponsor, and sites are to abide by all of the conditions and terms set forth in the regulations.
