I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Consultant Services Authorization (CSA) No. 25 to the contract with Hellmuth, Obata & Kassabaum, Inc. (HOK) (R2007-0033) in the amount of \$198,000 for the Jail Expansion Program II (JEP).

Summary: On April 25, 2006, the Board approved proceeding with the first phase of the Jail Expansion Program which consisted of the construction of the West County Detention Facility, West County Court Expansion, Stockade Redevelopment Site Preparation and Video Visitation System Improvements at the Main Detention Center. CSA No. 25 will provide construction administration services for the Courts Renovations portion of the project. HOK's Tampa office is the lead Architect and STH Architectural Group is the local architect working in conjunction with HOK. CSA No. 25 is funded from the Criminal Justice and Public Improvements Revenue Bond Series 2008. The Small Business Enterprises (SBE) goal for this project is 15%. CSA No. 25 includes 13.7% participation. When combined with the previous work done under this contract, the SBE participation is 16.4%. (Capital Improvements Division) Countywide (JM)

Background and Justification: On April 25, 2006, the Board approved proceeding with Jail Expansion Program II (JEP). Phase I of the JEP is the design and construction of the jail expansion in West County. Design services for Phase I have been completed.

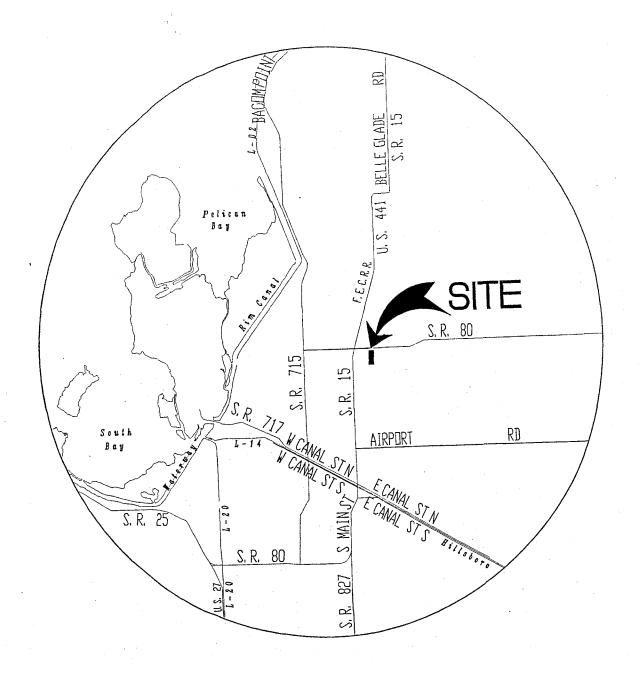

Additional Services

Description:

In accordance with Section 2 of the Contract for Architectural/Professional services, we herein request Additional Services related to the additional work effort required by the Design Team to complete Construction Administration Services for the Courts and Courts Support areas of the West County facility. The originally planned duration for Construction Administration expired in January 2011. This work was originally anticipated to have occurred concurrently with the construction of the New Jail or Renovation of the existing jail. The Courts Area construction has been shifted from the original construction sequence and therefore will cause additional time and work effort to the Design Team.

The Tract C Report prepared by Pulitzer/Bogard indicated the original area for the Courts was 25,000 s.f. This area was the basis by which the Design Team based the original construction fee with a planned duration of six (6) months. The current area of the Courts renovation is now 51,000 s.f. The area variance was agreed to by the County in CSA 09 which included additional design fees for the larger courts area as well as out of sequence changes. CSA 09 specifically excluded Construction Administration Services outside of the original construction duration.

This proposal includes credits for office time and field observation which would have been provided during the previous phases of new construction and renovation regardless of when that effort occurred. This proposal only includes costs for travel to and from the project site, additional time for bi-weekly OAC meetings, non-redundant field observation based on the larger area, and additional office time based on the larger area. In addition, this proposal resolves previously unresolved requests by the Design Team for extended Construction Administration Services related to the West County Detention Expansion and Addition.

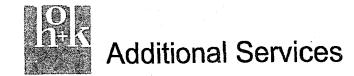

Project Amendment Description (West County Courts - Extended CA) - May 13, 2011

This project amendment is furnished at the request of the Client to address extended construction phase services at the West County Jail Courts site in Belle Glade, Florida.

The original scope of work for the courts component of the project did not include civil engineering services as all utility connections were to be made within the building footprint.

The scope of the project has since increased and there are now requirements for civil engineering services to include the collection and disposal of rainwater through various roof drains; condensate discharge to the storm system; new storm inlets and piping; and removal and replacement of the east parking area including provisions for secure judges parking. As such, there is no credit for original services to be performed under the basic agreement as civil engineering was not originally required as stated above.

Scope of Services

- 1. <u>Construction Administration Services</u>. Consultant will provide construction phase services and project certifications. Consultant's professional services in this regard include:
 - 1.1. Attend up to one preconstruction meeting with Client, PBC CID and selected contractor.

Pursuant to Section 2, paragraph(s) 2.1, 2.2, 2.2.1 of the "Prime agreement" dated January 09, 2007 we are hereby notifying you of additional work requiring extra compensation.

Reasoning for additional costs:

- 1. Landscape and Irrigation for the Courts area was not in the scope of the original contract.
- 2. Landscape and Irrigation installation on the balance of the West County Jail grounds are almost complete. The construction activity on the courts facilities adds a significant length of time to the original period of construction administration. This will result in a number of additional site visits.
