I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Title: Demonstration of *Palm Beach County Counts* (<u>www.pbccounts.org</u>) – A New Community Health Information Website for Palm Beach County

Summary: Palm Beach County, Economic Development Research Institute (EDRI) along with seven additional partners launch *Palm Beach County Counts*, an online research and data resource. This online source features 100 Palm Beach County quality of life indicators in the areas of economy, health, education, environment, transportation, public safety, government and politics, and social environment for PBC professionals, business leaders, and community members to access a broad range of local information for assessments, research and strategic planning.

Background: The community-based indicator program was developed in partnership with the Healthy Communities Institute, Inc. The goal was to design a dynamic, interactive web-based information system that will provide easy to understand data for all segments of the community to access at no charge. In addition to dashboard indicators and census information, the site will link visitors to more than 1,600 county-level promising practices and other planning resources that encourage and promote informed community action. In June 2011, the *Report of Health & Human Services in Palm Beach County – Based on Key Community Indicators 2010* was presented to the BCC. This report will be incorporated into *Palm Beach County Counts*.

The following organizations provide funding and governance for *Palm Beach County Counts*: The United Way of Palm Beach County, Children's Services Council of Palm Beach County, Health Care District of Palm Beach County, Quantum Foundation, Palm Healthcare Foundation, Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, and Workforce Alliance, Inc.



Palm Beach County Counts is a dynamic information portal that the local community can customize: uploading and underwriting increasingly sophisticated tools and data so that professionals, policy makers, and community members can access

- hundreds of free, authoritative, easy to understand INDICATORS on Palm Beach County that are updated daily across a broad range of topic areas (economy, health, government, etc.),
- examples of county-level programs and policies from across the nation that have been proven to be EFFECTIVE SOLUTIONS,
- easy to use, customizable data tracking and instant REPORTING TOOLS,
- an automatic feed of RESOURCES, services, news and events related to various indicators topic areas with ability to upload Palm Beach County specific reports and content, and
- CUSTOM WEBPAGES built to host, monitor indicators for and promote collaborative planning efforts taking place in the county so they can more effectively educate and engage the public.

The website's platform is provided by the Healthy Communities Institute; a company with growing national brand recognition for helping facilitate the advancement of vibrant, sustainable communities through the provision of locally customized data portals. All of the website's start-up costs have been underwritten by the local entities that make up the "Portal Collaborative" which sets operational and editorial policy for website, empowers a community based advisory committee to make recommendations on the websites content and application and selects a local agency to serve as a community outreach coordinator and local web administrator on an annual basis. Revenue generated from online sponsorships and custom research service fees will provide more than 50% of the projects revenue by 2015 with the remainder coming from the Portal Collaborative group of investors and other sources.

Palm Beach County Counts is a robust, 21st century tool needed to help maximize the cost efficiency and impact of strategic business, philanthropic and service investments in our community
