I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Second Amendment to Temporary Construction Easement (R-2009-0097) in favor of the City of Boynton Beach extending the term of the Easement.

Summary: The County's Caloosa Park is located south of Woolbright Road on the east side of Congress Avenue in Boynton Beach. On January 13, 2009, the County approved a Temporary Construction Easement (TCE) in favor of the City of Boynton Beach to install a sewer force main, landscape buffer and remove exotic vegetation on the eastern portion of the park property. The term of the TCE was for a period of one (1) year and expired on January 13, 2010. Due to unforeseen project development and fundraising issues, the project was delayed. On January 12, 2010, the Board approved a First Amendment to Temporary Construction Easement extending the term of the TCE to July 13, 2011 (R-2010-0081). The overall project is complete, except that the City has not signed off on the quality and success rate of the new landscaping material installed by the contractor. The City has a (1) year warranty with its contractor for growth and success rate of the landscape material and is therefore requesting to extend the term of the TCE until December 1, 2012. This will allow for replacement of any landscaping material which fails to meet City standards in the TCE area. Except for extension of the expiration date, all terms and conditions of the TCE shall remain in full force and effect. (PREM) District 3 (HJF)

Background and Justification: In January 2009, the County entered into an Interlocal Agreement and granted the City a Utility Easement and TCE for the installation of a force main to improve sanitary sewer services within the City. In return, the City agreed to remove exotic vegetation from the easement area and extend a reclaimed water line to the Caloosa Park boundary. The installation of the force main, removal of the exotic vegetation, and the extension of the reclaim water line have all been completed. This Amendment will extend the term of the TCE to allow for the replacement of any landscape material that fails during the contractor's warranty period.



SECOND AMENDMENT TO TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT ("Second Amendment") made ______ by and between PALM BEACH COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida ("County") whose mailing address is 301 North Olive Avenue, West Palm Beach, Florida 33401-4791, and CITY OF BOYNTON BEACH, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, whose mailing address is 100 East Boynton Beach Boulevard, Boynton Beach, Florida 33435-7934 ("Grantee").

RECITALS

Whereas, County granted Grantee a Temporary Construction Easement on January 13, 2009 (R2009-0097) (the "Easement"), the termination date of which has been extended; and

Whereas, County and Grantee wish to amend the Easement to further extend the termination date.

WITNESSETH:

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged by the parties, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference. Terms not defined herein shall have the same meaning as ascribed to them in the Easement, as amended.
- 2. The Easement is hereby modified to provide that the rights granted pursuant to the Easement shall expire and the Easement shall automatically terminate upon the earlier of Grantee's completion of the Project or December 1, 2012. Notwithstanding such automatic termination, Grantee shall promptly deliver to County a Release of Easement, in a form satisfactory to County, upon completion of the Project, if so requested by County.

- 3. Except as modified by this Second Amendment, the Easement, as amended, remains unmodified and in full force and effect and the parties hereby ratify, confirm, and adopt the Easement, as amended, in accordance with the terms thereof.
- 4. This Second Amendment is expressly contingent upon the approval of the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners, and shall become effective only when signed by all parties and approved by the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners.
