Background and Justification: The Westgate/Belvedere Homes Community Redevelopment Agency was created by the Board of County Commissioners pursuant to Ordinance No. 89-6, Section 3.05, adopted in May, 1989 and amended by Ordinance No. 91-50, adopted March, 1991. The CRA By-laws provide for the CRA Commissioners to elect their officers at a regular meeting immediately following the appointment of newly appointed CRA Commissioners by the Board of County Commissioners. The results of the election are forwarded to the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners for approval.

. 1 3.05. The Board of County Commissioners shall designate a chair 2 and vice chair from among the commissioners.

3 3.06. The agency may employ an executive director, technical 4 experts, and such other agents and employees, permanent and temporary, as 5 it may require, and determine their qualifications, duties, and 6 compensation. For such legal service as it may require, an agency may 7 employ or retain its own counsel and legal staff.

8 3.07. The agency shall file with the Board of County 9 Commissioners and with the Auditor General, on or before March 31st of each year, a certified audit report of its activities for the preceding 10 fiscal year, which report shall include a complete financial statement 11 setting forth its assets, liabilities, income, and operating expenses as 12 of the end of such fiscal year. At the time of filing the report, the 13 agency shall publish in a newspaper of general circulation in the 14 community a notice to the effect that such report has been filed with the 15 16 county and that the report is available for inspection during business 17 hours in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of County Counissioners and in the office of the Agency. 18

<u>3.08</u>. The Board of County Commissioners may remove a commissioner
for inefficiency, neglect of duty, or misconduct in office only after a
hearing and only if he has been given a copy of the charges at least ten
(10) days prior to such hearing and has had an opportunity to be heard in
person of by counsel.

3.09. The sgency shall have the power and authority to make and
issue such regulations, bylaws and rules as it deems necessary to
implement its powers and functions.

<u>3.10</u>. The officers, commissioners and employees of the Agency
shall be subject to the code of ethics as stated in the provisions and
requirements of Part III of Chapter 112, Floride Statutes (1987) and
Section 163.367, Floride Statutes (1987).
