### **I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF**

# Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to:

A) approve Contract with Brang Construction Incorporated in the amount of \$2,498,035 for the construction of the South Cove Natural Area Restoration Project within the City of West Palm Beach, Project No. 2011ERM02 for a period of 190 calendar days;

**B) adopt** a Resolution authorizing the Clerk of the Board to disburse \$215,000 from the Vessel Registration Fee Trust Fund;

**C)** approve a Budget Transfer of \$215,000 in Vessel Registration Fees in the Environmental Enhancement Non-Specific Fund from reserves to the South Cove Natural Area Restoration Project; and

**D)** approve a Budget Transfer of \$800,000 in the Natural Areas Fund from the Manatee Protection Program to the South Cove Restoration Project.

**Summary:** This project includes filling a dredged hole with sand to create mangrove islands, planters and seagrass habitat. Rock will be placed to create oyster reefs and stabilize the islands and planters. Public access features will include a boardwalk, observation deck and kiosk. Five (5) eligible bids were received for this project. A bid protest delayed this construction procurement for one (1) month. Brang Construction Incorporated, a Palm Beach County Small Business Enterprise (SBE) company, was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder with a bid that exceeds the established 15% SBE goal with 22.91% participation. Approval of the resolution and budget transfers will provide \$1,015,000 to match grant funding from Florida Inland Navigation District and the Lake Worth Lagoon Partnership Grant Program. District 7 (JM)

**Background and Justification**: Bids were received through the Department of Environmental Resources Management by the Board of County Commissioners on April 26, 2011.



RESOLUTION NO. 2011-\_\_\_\_ 1 2 3 4 **RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY** 5 **COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY** 6 7 FLORIDA TO UTILIZE A PORTION OF THE COUNTY VESSEL REGISTRATION FEES TO COVER THE 8 COSTS OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE SOUTH COVE NATURAL AREA RESTORATION PROJECT. 9 10 11 12 WHEREAS, Palm Beach County enacted the Vessel Registration Fee Ordinance, No. 13 14 88-40 which began collecting fees June 1, 1989; and WHEREAS, the Vessel Registration Fee Ordinance provides that monies collected 15 from vessel registration fees be utilized to protect coastal marine and estuarine habitats, 16 maintain and enhance fisheries and other salt and freshwater habitats, and construct artificial 17 reefs; and 18 WHEREAS, the South Cove Natural Area Restoration Project is a high priority 19 project in the Board of County Commissioner's approved Lake Worth Lagoon Management 20 Plan; and 21 WHEREAS, the South Cove Natural Area Restoration project is located in the Lake 22 Worth Lagoon in the City of West Palm Beach; and 23 WHEREAS, the project will restore critical shallow water habitat and improve water 24 quality by filling a deep anoxic dredge hole and capping muck sediment; and 25 WHEREAS, the project will create 3.5 acres of seagrass habitat, 2 acres of intertidal 26 mangrove and spartina habitat, and 0.9 acres of oyster reefs; and 27 WHEREAS, \$215,000 a portion of the County's contribution to pay to construct the 28 project will come from the County's Vessel Registration Fee Trust Fund; and 29 30 WHEREAS, the Director of Environmental Resources Management recommends that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the Clerk of the Board to disburse Vessel 31 Registration Fee monies in the Environmental Enhancement Non-Specific Fund in the 32 amount of \$215,000 for the South Cove Natural Area Restoration Project. The remainder is 33 funded by FIND, Manatee Protection Program, Vessel Registration Fees and the Lake Worth 34 Lagoon Partnership Grant Program. 35 36
