**Summary:** The Office of Small Business Assistance, Department of Airports and Palm Tran are participating with the South Florida Water Management District, School District of Palm Beach County, the City of West Palm Beach, the City of Riviera Beach, the Center for Technology, Enterprise & Development, Inc. (TED Center) and the Paragon Foundation, Inc., to present the 2011 Business Matchmaker Conference & Expo (a statewide conference). This is the 5th annual Matchmaker Conference & Expo held in Palm Beach County. Each participating entity will contribute \$2,000 and the county's contribution will be broken down as follows: the Office of Small Business Assistance (\$2,000), Department of Airports (\$2,000) and Palm Tran (\$2,000).
