Dear County Commissioners,

On Monday July 25, 2011, the West Palm Beach City Commission adopted Resolution No. 187-11 urging Palm Beach County not to increase its millage rate for Fiscal Year 2011/2012. The City Commission appeals to the Board of Commissioners of Palm Beach County to take every reasonable action necessary to hold the County millage rate flat. A copy of the resolution is attached.

Palm Beach County has been hit hard over the past five years by the economic downturn. Unemployment remains high at around 10%. Property values continue to decline while foreclosure actions were initiated on another 1,061 properties within the County during the month of June. Our residences and business need all of the financial relief that we in government can provide. The City of West Palm Beach has taken extraordinary measures to reduce spending levels while minimizing the impact to our constituents. Over the last three years the City's millage rate has remained level providing our taxpayers with a reduced City tax liability as property values have declined.
