Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: Grant Adjustment Notice amending the National Institute of Justice FY 2009 Forensic DNA Unit Efficiency Improvement Program Grant to extend the grant period from September 30, 2011, through September 30, 2012.

Summary: The Board of County Commissioners accepted this grant for \$519,544 on December 15, 2009; the original period for this grant was October 1, 2009,through March 31, 2011 (R-2009-2164). On March 1, 2011, the BOCC received and filed an agenda item extending the grant period from March 31, 2011, through September 30, 2011 (R-2011-0311). This agenda item will extend the grant period from September 30, 2011, through September 30, 2012. The National Institute of Justice awarded these funds for an evidence screening laboratory to improve the capacity and efficiency of the Forensic Biology Unit (FBU) of PBSO. The screening laboratory will be developed through renovation of existing space in the Boca Raton Police Services Department in which trained Laboratory Analyst will screen and process crime scene items before submission to the FBU. The Boca Raton Police Services Department will provide the required 25% match requirement associated with this award.
