## I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:** a Budget Transfer of \$86,758 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETf) to the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (PBSO).

**Summary:** Florida Statute 932.7055 requires that no less than 15% of the LETF's previous year's revenues be used for the support or operation of drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood and school resource officer programs of various non-profit organizations. The PBSO's FY 2011 estimated donation requirement is \$98,015. The funds are requested to aid qualified organizations that meet the requirements set forth in F.S. 932.7055. The PBSO's support of these programs exemplifies its strong commitment to the prevention and reduction of crime throughout the communities it serves and its desire to put money back into these communities to support organizations that provide such services. The current State LETF balance is \$1,614,611. Approval of this request will reduce the State Law Enforcement Trust Fund balance to \$1,527,853. The year-to-date transfer for all donations after approval of this item is \$1,454,442. The PBSO certifies that the use of these funds is in accordance with F.S. 932.7055. Below is a table indicating the organizations the PBSO seeks to fund and the corresponding amount of funding proposed per respective agency. The PBSO certifies that the use of these funds is in accordance with F.S. 932.7055.




Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded: The artists will work with middle school children in underserved neighborhoods, providing musical theatre programming designed to promote intercultural understanding. The artists will include a trio (cello, piano, and percussion) and an actor. Working in after-school standards and benchmarks of the Florida Sunshine State Educational Standards. Performances by the artists will be followed by hands-on learning experiences focusing on rhythm, melody, harmony, listening and writing exercises. Working in after-school sites, the project will take place in January and February, 2011. Activities will be linked to the benchmarks of the Florida Sunshine State Educational Standards. Performances by the artists will be followed by hands-on learning experiences focusing on rhythm, melody, harmony, listening and writing exercises. Theatre games will offer avenues for self-expression and an opportunity to learn to give and take constructive criticism. The Core Ensemble will offer a PBSO facilitated program on gang awareness for its clients and parents. The Core Ensemble will offer a second PBSO facilitated program on missing and exploited children called Take 25 also for the organizations' clients and parents.

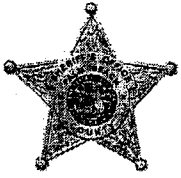



2. Organizations Purpose The Ann Norton Sculpture Gardens maintains a health-giving, life-giving ecological benefit to the citizens of its adjacent and surrounding communities, in order to further the common good and welfare of the people in those communities. The Gardens' *Community Enrichment Program*, in an effort to better serve the community, sets the standard for good stewardship of the Gardens for future generations, fosters collaborative partnerships with other cultural and environmental organizations in the county and provides educational opportunities to all populations with an emphasis on at-risk youth.
3. Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded:

ANSG will present an exhibition of works by artist Elizabeth Catlett, Jan.-Feb. 2011. The Gardens is seeking \$3,665 toward the facilitation of educational programs for this project. Grant funds will be used to ensure the exhibition project is accessible to at-risk students from Title I schools as well as low-moderate income level communities. Funds will specifically provide: an accessible on-line catalog/documentary about Catlett, guided group tours & interactive curriculum for 400 students & teachers from Title I schools grades 4-8, strategically distributed marketing to invite and include low-moderate income communities and minority communities. The Ann Norton Sculpture Gardens will offer a Palm Beach Sheriffs Office facilitated program (December 2010) on gang awareness for the organization's clients and parents. ANSG will offer a second PBSO facilitated program (April 2011) on missing and exploited children called Take 25 also for the organization's clients and parents.
4. What results are you committed to achieving? This exhibit/project is a view of African American life, history and culture through Catlett's unique perspective. Catlett quoted in *Art: African American*. "I learned how you use your art for service of people, struggling people". I have always wanted my art to--reflect us, to relate to us, to stimulate us, to make us aware of our potential," Catlett's work captures the heroic quality, strength, and dignity of African Americans and benefits all people by preserving African American history and culture. This project is particularly critical for young African American students because the majority of art history or cultural education focuses on great works created by artists they have little in common with Elizabeth Catlett forged the way so that she could teach and inspire people similar to her as well as those different from her. The Gardens' is committed to: 1). Creating safer neighborhoods by exhibiting art that expresses and promotes tolerance. 2). Empowering families and students through education and awareness of the African American History and Culture Catlett strove to preserve. 3) Providing educational opportunities that recognize cultural similarities rather than differences. 4) Providing a positive example of citizenship through Catlett's life, philosophy and contributions.



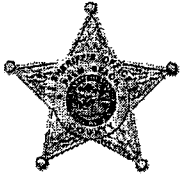

2. **Organization Purpose:** To promote and display the creative works and contributions of Artists of color through the visual and performing arts and to develop awareness for the educational enrichment of all children and adults through multi-cultural diversity.

3. **Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded:** The Youth Outreach Program targets and addresses the need for greater opportunities for at-risk ethnic students who live in underserved arts communities. The classes are held during after school hours between 3:30 and 6:30 P.M. The program will address the needs of the community by offering fine art training to different age groups at J.A.Y. Ministries in Riviera Beach, St. George Center in Riviera Beach and Noah ark International Charter School in Riviera Beach. The program classes and workshops provide a safe place to develop positive self-esteem, respect for others, life skills of communication, cooperation, conflict resolution, problem solving, organizational skills, time management and leadership skills. Our programs have lowered truancy by providing these enrichment classes to prevent idle time, un-supervised afterschool time when many youths get into trouble. Field trips and art exhibits are provided for students throughout the year. Certificates of achievement are given to students who complete the program.

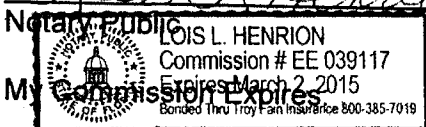

3. Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded: \_\_\_\_\_

*This grant will be used to help fund our Tiger Paws initiative – a writing club held in the important afterschool hours at North Grade Elementary School in Lake Worth. We selected North Grade for this project because they have a high English language learner and immigrant population, many of their students have challenging economic backgrounds, and many are at risk of failure in school. Through Tiger Paws, we will engage approximately 25 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> graders in writing poetry, fiction, and personal essay and in creating visual art and photography that gets gathered into a multi-lingual literary webzine. Because many of our students speak Spanish or Kanjobal (a Mayan language spoken in the Yucatan and Guatemala) as their first language, we connect them with students at Habla: The Center for Language and Culture in Merida, Mexico. We coordinate our lesson plans with the Habla teachers, and their students contribute their work to Tiger Paws, as well. Blue Planet Writers' Room will also offer a PBSO-facilitated program on gang awareness for North Grade's students and parents. Blue Planet will offer a second PBSO-facilitated program on missing and exploited children called Take 25, also for North Grade's students and parents*

4. What results are you committed to achieving? \_\_\_\_\_

*We find that the combination of the international collaboration and the literary webzine provides a powerful incentive to our students to write creatively and revise carefully. The promise of an authentic audience for their work really spurs them on to success. And because we enable them to write in their native languages as well as in English, we – and their classroom teachers and principal – find that their self-confidence and their pride in their heritages grows significantly, as well. In addition, Tiger Paws gives them a fun, creative, and educational activity to fill their critical afterschool time, when so many young people are at risk of being idle and participating in destructive, rather than constructive, activities.*

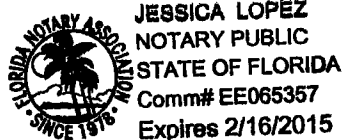

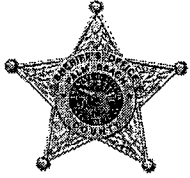

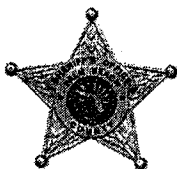

The focus of The Children's Coalition Inc. is to create an immediate and long-term positive impact in the lives of at-risk youth by providing hands-on education in media arts and technology.

**VISION STATEMENT**

The promise of The Children's Coalition Inc. is to cultivate children to become self-reliant and contributing members within their community by developing skills, opening doors, and providing economic opportunities.

**Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded:** TCCI offers year-round, during and after-school computer and multi-media arts (**SOCIALIZED ARTS**) and entrepreneurship workshops to students, ages 6 through 22. These students are drawn primarily from economically disadvantaged neighborhoods located in and around West Palm Beach, Florida ("West Palm Beach"). Students are referred for entry into our programs by the Palm Beach County School Board, Palm Beach County Department of Children and Families and the Palm Beach County Department of Juvenile Justice based on low academic performance (D's and/or F's in two subject areas) and status as first time or repeat criminal offenders as defined by the Palm Beach County Department of Juvenile Justice.

We presently receive referrals and provide workshop outreach services to the following organizations: Palm Beach County Court System, Departments of Juvenile Justice and Children and Families; The Palm Beach County Youth Empowerment Centers; and the Palm Beach County School Board. We offer technology and computer/multi-media skills workshops to juveniles at their detention center locations, at "aftercare" programs upon their release into the community, at alternative education centers, and on an after-school basis. We differentiate ourselves in the market by aiming not only to meet the needs of the student participants in TCCI's workshops, but also to benefit the surrounding community. TCCI emphasizes life skills and training that increases eventual productivity and decrease recidivism among our target

population. The Children's Coalition will offer a PBSO facilitated program on gang awareness for its clients and parents. The Children's Coalition will offer a second PBSO facilitated program on missing and exploited children called Take 25 also for the organizations' clients and parents.

**Activity Timeline:** Each student takes part in at least two workshops a week on an ongoing basis, (workshops will be scheduled five days a week, afternoon and after-school sessions) to accommodate more than 250 students over the yearlong project period. Experts will instruct workshops where students will learn computer/Internet skills, still life photography, video production, desktop publishing, fashion design, quilt making/sewing skills. Students work on class projects in the beginning and then will go on to work on their own original art projects as part of their ongoing workshop where they learn skills, have access to expert guidance, and work on their own independent projects as they attain higher skill levels in a particular art medium. **(PLEASE SEE SCHEDULE ATTACHED)**

TCCI provides access to entrepreneurship workshops (**emphasizing socialized skills in the arts**) for students ages 13 and older to foster the development of business design and marketing skills. Students work as a team in creating a business to showcase and market their services and showcase and sell original artwork. With adult guidance, students organize exhibitions of their artwork in public centers and business organizations. Students market their photography, fashion design, and video production skills to the community. Students negotiate contracts and complete work on schedule. Students also have the opportunity to sell their work at exhibitions and students will showcase their work at festival events throughout the year. A portion of the proceeds from sales is invested back into the program. Students develop writing and math skills as they keep track of their finances, budget projects, purchase supplies and provide negotiated services. Students learn grant-writing skills in addition to financial accounting skills as part of the skill sets taught in the entrepreneurial workshops. Students learn marketing and graphic design skills as they develop brochures to market the services of individual students and the group.

Students apprentice with adult workshop experts to develop their skills and entrepreneurship abilities. Stipends are provided to older students (when the budget allows) so that they are able to work with their younger counterparts. Students receiving stipends also assist workshop leaders both inside and outside the classroom (particularly in cases in which services are provided to the general public).

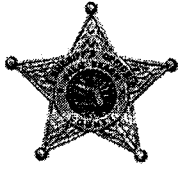

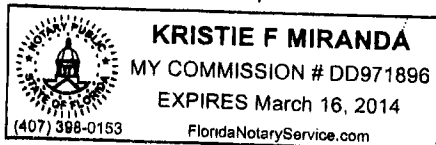

2. Organization Purpose:

*Since 1979, The Children's Place at Home Safe, Inc. d.b.a. Home Safe has served children and youth, impacted by abuse, neglect, abandonment, and family violence. Our mission statement is "Children are our future and deserve the opportunity to develop within a nurturing, safe and positive environment. Home Safe is a nationally accredited leader in proactively meeting the needs of our community through innovative and responsive services that empower, shape and enrich the lives of children and families".*

3. Provide a brief summary of program's activities/services to be funded:

***The Safety Net Violence Prevention & Intervention Program** was implemented as a partnership between Home Safe and the State Attorney's Office in 1998. The program offers a full spectrum of services for victims of family violence; year-round adult, teen and child support groups, individual therapy, crisis intervention, preventative education and court advocacy to victims of family violence. We strive to encourage change in family relationships with an emphasis on non-violent communication, mutual respect and healthy home environments.*

*Home Safe's **Arts Away** program has, over the past four years, been a successful collaboration with the Center for Creative Education (CCE), an organization that brings artists from the community to work with the children participating in our **Safety Net: Domestic Violence Prevention and Intervention** program. The program provides individual and group therapy to victims of Domestic Violence and their children in Palm Beach County. The program teaches critical skills, aimed at preventing violence, with the goal of enabling participants to create a safe home that is free of abusive relationships and of recurrent events of battery/assault, direct or witnessed. Safety Net now serves more than 200 children and teens annually. Beyond treating the primary adult target of abuse, treatment for children and teens who bear witness to familial violence is essential. There is a proven relationship between child maltreatment (abuse, neglect, and witnesses to familial violence) leading to perpetrating or participating in violent teen dating relationships, increased juvenile delinquency, vulnerability towards gang involvement and the propensity to continue the intergenerational cycle of family abuse.*

*The teens and children involved in Arts Away activities communicate through the medium in which they are working (clay, painting, music, collages, decorative crafts and more), share with each other, and often begin to open up previously unspoken words about the trauma they have endured. For some who are initially more reserved, are just beginning to open up, or are reticent to try new things, it may be their first line of communication; one that may bring about further communication and facilitate active participation in individual and group therapy sessions. Many have found new hidden talents that have not been encouraged or expressed prior to involvement in artistic endeavors. Research clearly demonstrates that the arts help children focus, learn, set and achieve goals and improves communication with people of all walks of life.*

*This past year, the Safety Net teen group members participated in making a film "Letters Home: The Autobiography of Carlos Diaz". The teens, with assistance from several CCE artists, wrote the script, memorized and practiced their lines, and the film was completed in December, 2009. The film addressed issues of domestic and teen violence, the lure of gang-life, teen pregnancy and substance abuse. The film premiered in February, 2010 to a full house at the Stage West theatre at Palm Beach State College. The film is being used to educate the community on issues impacting teens and families today. It has been shown on Spanish speaking channel Mega 57 all during October, which is Domestic Violence Awareness Month.*

#### **4. What results are you committed to achieving?**

*The Safety Net Program is committed to continuing to provide therapeutic art sessions to our clients who witnessed family violence. Monthly sessions will be provided to our Tuesday and Wednesday child and teen groups. Satisfaction surveys will continue to be administered to all of the youth to determine how the expressive arts assisted them in dealing with the trauma they have experienced.*

*The Safety Net Teen Advisory Council will be presenting the film "Letters Home" to various organizations, church groups and other venues to educate the community about domestic and teen dating violence, the consequences of gang life, teen pregnancy and substance abuse. Artwork created by the children will be displayed in the community to also showcase the impact of domestic violence on kids and teens. Overall, the Arts Away Program has been a vital enhancement to The Safety Net Program and our community.*
