I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Amendment No. 1 to the Contract for Provision of Financial Assistance with Governor's Council for Community Health Partnerships, Inc. (R2011-0607), for the period of May 1, 2011, through September 30, 2011, increasing the contract amount by \$20,000, for a new not-to-exceed total amount of \$467,365, for Summer Camp Scholarships.

Summary: The Summer Camp Scholarship Program pays full tuition and associated fees for eligible children to attend day camp during the summer months. Governor's Council for Community Health Partnerships, Inc. (GCCHP) processes payments to the specific summer camp providers based on invoices from PBC Division of Human Services. The initial contract amount of \$447,365 has been expended to fund summer camp scholarships for eligible children. GCCHP has the need to fund the cost of children placed in alternate summer camp sites when an approved camp accommodating 44 scholarship children closed unexpectedly without meeting its contract obligations. The County Attorney's Office is working with the GCCHP to recover funds prepaid to the camp. The cost for this amendment is from unexpended Division funds. (Human Services) Countywide (TKF)

Background & Justification: Since 1995, GCCHP has provided support for the Summer Camp Scholarship Program in collaboration with the Department of Community Services. GCCHP develops and implements marketing strategies to raise additional funding for the Summer Camp Scholarship Program. GCCHP has other initiatives that serve the residents of Palm Beach County. These initiatives include: Gift Card Incentives for the Point-In-Time Count, Toy Drive for Indigent Residents, and receipt of donations for Homeless Services and the Division of Senior Services.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the AGENCY has the need to cover the cost of children placed in alternate summer camp sites when the initial camp closed while working to recover funds from the camp; whereas the need exists to amend the contract to increase the total contract amount.

NOW THEREFORE, the above named parties hereby mutually agree that the Contract entered into on May 3rd, 2011 is hereby amended as follows:

- I. Article 3 is hereby amended to read, an amount not to exceed <u>Four Hundred and Sixty Seven Thousand Three Hundred and Sixty Five Dollars (\$467,365).</u>
- II. Exhibit "D" is hereby amended to read:
 - a. GCCHP is allocated \$467,365 in funding from PBCBCC to support the Summer Camp Scholarship Program. (Third paragraph)
 - b. 2011 Program Budget reads:
 - i. Summer Camp Scholarships: \$458,615
 - ii. Total: \$467,365

OTHER PROVISIONS

All provisions in the Contract or exhibits to the Contract in conflict with this First Amendment to the Contract shall be and are hereby changed to conform to this amendment.

All provisions not in conflict with this Amendment are still in effect and are to be performed at the same level as specified in the Contract.

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CONTRACT FOR PROVISION OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

This Contract is made as of the ____ day of _____, 2011, by and between the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, Florida, hereinafter referred to as the COUNTY, and ___ The Governor's Council for Community Health Partnerships Inc. hereinafter referred to as the AGENCY, a not-for-profit corporation authorized to do business in the State of Florida, whose Federal Tax I.D. is _65-0449910.

Whereas the AGENCY has proposed providing Summer Camp Scholarship Funding Administration for low income Palm Beach County residents; and

Whereas the AGENCY has agreed to assure access to funded services for COUNTY departments, divisions and/or programs; and to assure that individuals referred from COUNTY departments, divisions and/or programs will receive services on a timely basis;

In consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the COUNTY and the AGENCY agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1 - SERVICES

The AGENCY agrees to provide services to residents of Palm Beach County as set forth in the Scope of Work in Exhibit "A". The AGENCY also agrees to provide deliverables, including reports, as specified in Schedule of Payments detailed in Exhibits "A" and "B." No changes in the scope of work are to be conducted without the written approval of the Palm Beach County Community Services Department (the DEPARTMENT).

ARTICLE 2 - SCHEDULE

The AGENCY shall commence services on May 1st 2011 and complete services on September 30, 2011.

ARTICLE 3 - PAYMENTS

The COUNTY shall pay to the AGENCY for services rendered under this contract, an amount not to exceed Four Hundred and Sixty Seven Thousand Three Hundred and Sixty Five Dollars (\$467,365.00). The AGENCY shall bill the COUNTY on at least a monthly basis, for Summer Camp Scholarships and fiscal administration provided as indicated by Exhibit "A" and expenses actually incurred and paid, up to the amounts set forth in Exhibit "B." In no case shall the total cumulative amount billed under this contract exceed the

The Governor's Council for Community Health Partnerships, Inc. (GCCHP) is a collaborative, non-profit, tax exempt, 501(c)3 corporation of community partners under the leadership of the Palm Beach County Health Department (PBCHD) that:

- Works with the PBCHD to prioritize needs, form task groups, plan strategies, and pools
- Designs programs and creates committees to address specific issues.
- Identifies programs with limited financial resources, and acts as a conduit to enable them to receive private hands-on support and funding.
- Serves as an incubator for start-up programs exploring establishing their own non-profit status.
- Recognizes and celebrates individuals and organizations in the PBC community who make outstanding contributions to their mission.

Since 1995, GCCHP has provided support for the Summer Camp Scholarship Program. The Program assures school aged children are not home alone during the summer months and continue to receive nutritious meals in the summer.

GCCHP is allocated \$467,365 in funding from PBCBCC to support the Summer Camp Scholarship Program. GCCHP processes payments to the specific Summer Camp providers based on invoices from PBC Division of Human Services. GCCHP maintains financial records and reports of payments and receipts for Summer Camp funding. In addition, GCCHP's Summer Camp Scholarship Sub-committee develops and implements marketing strategies to raise additional funding for the Summer Camp Scholarship Program.
