#### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: Consulting Services Authorization (CSA) No. 5 to Contract with Saltz Michelson Architects, Inc. (R2008-0378) in the amount of \$119,549 for architectural and engineering services related to the shell/build out of a portion the first floor space at the Four Points Office Building.

Summary: CSA No. 5 will provide for the design, permitting and construction administration services for the last phase of the continuing improvements for the Four Points Office Building consisting of relocating Information Systems Services (ISS) Platform and Enterprise Services and Data Center from the Government Center. This move will provide a hardened location for the Data Center as the Four Points Office Building has been recently renovated to withstand 180 mph winds. Relocating the Data Center will secure the County's network servers and provide redundant utilities and a higher level of back-up power generation for this critical function. Funding for this project is from the Public Building Improvement Fund. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for this contract is 25%. Saltz Michelson is providing 62% SBE participation. When added to the Consultant's participation to date, the resulting SBE participation is 31.6%. Saltz Michelson Architects, Inc. is a Palm Beach County firm. (Capital Improvements Division) District 2 (JM)

**Background and Justification:** This authorization is necessary to complete the last phase of the improvements at the Four Points Office Building in order to relocate ISS's Platform and Enterprise Services which includes the Data Center currently located on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor of the Government Center. This move will make approximately 12,000 square feet of space available in the Government Center for a future tenant.

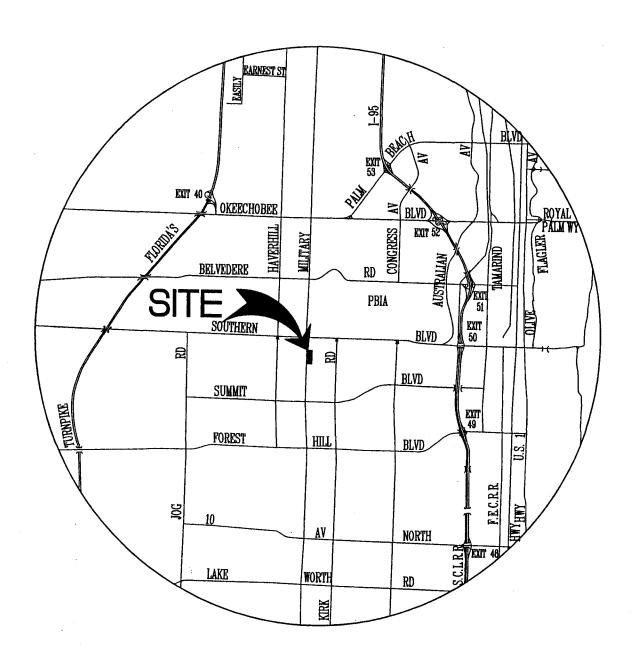

Dear Theo:

This proposal supersedes previous proposal dated 08-03-11 It was revised as per PBC A. Patel's request.

This is to present our proposal for design associated with the referenced project. As you know we have held several meetings before today and have performed some preliminary design that has allowed PBC to become aware of the magnitude of the principal modifications that will be required at the existing installation.

The following scope summarizes the principal design details as we understand them:

- 1. ISS will occupy the southern half of the lower level at Four Points (4P).
- 2. Within that space, a new server room of approximately 2,000 SF will be built. The design of the Server room support MEPFP infrastructure will be based on the following parameters:
  - a. The UPS capacity of the server room will be two (2) 200kW units, each supplying 50% of the ultimate server capacity. UPS's shall be expandable to 250kW each; MEP infrastructure will be sized for 250kW of load.
  - b. As discussed in all previous meetings:
    - Circuit distribution from PDU's to rack mounted servers will be part of the UPS vendor contract (APC) and is not included in Gartek design fee. Branch circuit cabling will be pre-manufactured at the required lengths and UL listed for the application.
    - Electrical design fee includes, and electrical contractor will install, electrical feeders between UPS's and all PDU's.
    - Electrical design fee includes, and electrical contractor will install, electrical branch circuits between PDU's and floor mounted (non-racked) equipment.
    - Mechanical design fee includes, and mechanical contractor will install, chilled water piping and all connections to the APC supplied A/C units.

This is as discussed in all the meetings we have had to date and it is important to understand that design of electrical branch circuits between the PDU's and rack mounted equipment is not included in our fee in case the County decides to make other arrangements or select other vendors who are not aware of this arrangement.

This proposal supersedes previous proposal dated 08-03-11 It was revised as per PBC A. Patel's request.

- c. Certain equipment to be relocated from the existing server room in the Government Center to the new server room at Four Points will be installed on the floor of the new server room and will not be configured in a cold-aisle type arrangement. APC is to supply an additional PDU for this equipment. Gartek will design, and contractor will install, wiring for this equipment (as opposed to the arrangement described in item "b" above).
- d. ISS will be using a cold-aisle HVAC concept for the new server equipment.
- e. HVAC redundancy will be built into the system. Approximately 60% redundancy (at ultimate peak demand) will be provided. The existing chillers at Four Points will not (cannot) be used to supply chilled water to the Server Room.
- A dedicated generator will be provided to supply ISS server load. The existing generator at Four Points will not be used as a back-up to the new ISS generator.
- PBC does not want to use a Clean Agent Fire Suppression system for the server room. Fire Protection design will be based on a Pre-Action dry pipe sprinkler system, including the underfloor area. Not providing a clean agent system for the underfloor will require that cabling pathways be identified on the documents for any future IT cabling infrastructure installation.
- h. PBC prefers that an additional fuel tank NOT be installed at the facility to supply the ISS dedicated generator. Gartek has submitted fuel run-times for several generator-fuel tank combinations. This proposal is based on using the existing 3,000 gallon fuel tank; this arrangement will provide approximately 1.7 days of fuel supply for both generators at this site.
- 3. Scope includes minor interior renovations to already completed MEPFP plans of the space.

Our fee for the above described scope of services will be \$64,115.00 as indicated below and on the attached man-hour breakdown.
