AMENDMENT TO THE ANNUAL ASPHALT MILLING & RESURFACING CONTRACT NO. 2011051, DATED AUGUST 17, 2010, BY AND BETWEEN COMMUNITY ASPHALT CORPORATION, AND PALM BEACH COUNTY

THIS AMENDMENT to the Annual Asphalt Milling & Resurfacing Contract (Primary) dated August 17, 2010, (R-2010-1216), hereinafter "CONTRACT" by and between Community Asphalt Corporation, hereinafter "CONTRACTOR" and the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter, "COUNTY".
