I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff requests Board direction on:

- A) Adopting a Resolution to approve Amendment Number Eight to the County Incentive Grant Program Agreement R2001-2157 (Agreement) with the State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to provide for a reallocation of up to \$1,000,000 of the existing matching roadway construction funding for median beautification on Okeechobee Boulevard from State Road 7 to Florida's Turnpike (Improvements) and a Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement (MMOA) to ensure the maintenance of the Improvements;
- B) Approving an exception to the 2002 policy that restricts Palm Beach County's (County). installation of median beautification to areas that are unincorporated and not contiguous to a municipality;
- C) Approving an Interlocal Agreement with the City of West Palm Beach (City) under which the City agrees to accept all maintenance obligations for the Improvements; and
- **D)** Authorizing the County Engineer or his designee to issue a Task Authorization not-to-exceed \$1,000,000 to construct the Improvements utilizing the Annual Roadway Landscaping Contract.

SUMMARY: If the funding is not approved, the FDOT will be responsible for mowing the medians and swales along this 3+ mile stretch of road. They currently mow approximately seven times per year. Adoption of the resolution to approve Amendment Number Eight and approve the MMOA will establish a reallocation of up to \$1,000,000 of budgeted but unused roadway construction funding for the Improvements and will obligate the County to maintain the Improvements. The County will then pass the maintenance obligations to the City. Approval of the Interlocal Agreement will obligate the City to accept all maintenance responsibilities for the Improvements. In accordance with the terms of the original Agreement, 50/50 (County/FDOT) matching funding would be utilized to install the Improvements. The County's one-time cost of \$500,000 is available in the roadway project's previously approved budget.

Districts 2 & 6 (MRE)

Background and Justification: On December 18, 2001, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved the Agreement with FDOT for the eight laning of Okeechobee Boulevard from west of State Road 7 to Florida's Turnpike (Project). The Agreement was approved by FDOT on February 28, 2002, and provides the County with financial assistance for the Project.


B. Recommended Sources of Funds/Summary of Fiscal Impact:

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

Amendment Number One (R2004-0546) revised the Project schedule. Amendment Number Two (R2006-1060) revised the Project limits, funding amounts and schedule. Amendment Number Three (R2007-0455) approved additional funds. Amendment Number Four (R2008-0303) extended the contract time and modified the limits to cover a greater portion of the Project. Amendments Number Five (R2010-0558) and Six extended the expiration date of the Agreement. Amendment Number Seven (R2011-0714) extended the expiration date of the Agreement from June 30, 2011 to December 31, 2011, and added the E-Verify requirement, per Executive Order 11-02 by Florida's Governor. Amendment Number Eight will establish a reallocation of up to \$1,000,000 of budgeted, but unused roadway construction funding for the Improvements. In accordance with the terms of the original Agreement, as was the case with the road project, 50/50 (County/FDOT) matching funding would be utilized to install the Improvements.

Approval of an exception to the policy that restricts the County's installation of median beautification to areas that are unincorporated and not contiguous to a municipality will enable staff to proceed with the installation of the Improvements. Approval of the MMOA will obligate the County to provide ongoing maintenance of the Improvements; however approval of the Interlocal Agreement with the City will delegate all the maintenance responsibilities for the Improvements to the City.
