I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: the First Amendment, amending the agreement with the City of Miramar, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, as the fiscal agent for the Ft. Lauderdale Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) to extend the agreement period for the Regional Virtual Fusion Center from May 31, 2011, through August 31, 2011.

Summary: On January 12, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners accepted this agreement to provide \$336,900 in reimbursable funding; the original period for this agreement was August 27, 2009, through May 31, 2011 (R-2010-0121). This agenda item will extend the agreement period from May 31, 2011, through August 31, 2011. This agreement provides a means of funding various domestic security activities within the County and region using federal Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) funds through the City of Miramar as the Ft. Lauderdale UASI's fiscal agent. These funds and related equipment will be used for the Regional Virtual Fusion Center hosted by PBSO. There is no match requirement associated with this award. No additional positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. <u>Countywide (GB)</u>

Background and Justification:

The Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) is intended is to create a sustainable national model program to enhance security and overall preparedness to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism. In general, the UASI provides financial assistance to States to address the unique equipment, training, planning, and exercise needs of large urban areas, and to assist them in building an enhanced and sustainable capacity to prevent, respond to, and recover from threats or acts of terrorism. FIRST AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FOR PARTICIPATING FORT LAUDERDALE UASI AGENCIES

This First Amendment to Memorandum of Agreement for Participating Fort Lauderdale UASI Agencies (the "First Amendment") is entered into this day of Sept 2011, by and between the City of Miramar, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida (the "Sponsoring Agency") and <u>Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office,</u> a political subdivision of the of the State of Florida (the "Participating Agency").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Sponsoring Agency and the Participating Agency entered into a Memorandum of Agreement for Participating Fort Lauderdale UASI Agencies dated <u>August 27, 2009</u> (the "MOA") related to expenditures of funds subgranted to the Participating Agency under the FY 2008 Urban Area Security Initiative ("UASI") Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the participating agency was allocated **\$336,900.00** to be expended and reimbursed pursuant to the terms of the MOA. This sum was allocated for a regional project to fund equipment and personnel for the South Florida Virtual Fusion Center.

WHEREAS, the current term of the MOA ended on May 31, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the MOA is subject to all terms, provisions and conditions of the Federally Funded Subgrant Agreement between the Sponsoring Agency and the State of Florida, Division of Emergency Management (the "State Agreement"), the current term of which also ended on May 31, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Sponsoring Agency has applied to the State of Florida for an extension of the term of the State Agreement in order to provide additional time for the

completion of procurement and the expenditure of the grant funding available under the FY 2008 UASI Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has agreed, subject to execution of a written contract modification, to extend the State Agreement through August 31, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the parties mutually desire to extend the term of the MOA through the same extension date as approved by the State of Florida for the State Agreement, to wit: August 31, 2011, in order to provide additional time for the completion of the procurement process and the expenditure of the grant funding available under the FY 2008 UASI Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. In conjunction with the extension of the State Agreement through August 31, 2011, the term of the MOA between the parties shall be extended to August 31, 2011. 2. All terms, provisions and conditions of the MOA not inconsistent with this First Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
