Summary: On May 1, 2007, the Board of County Commissioners established the Homeless Advisory Board to develop a Ten-Year Plan to End Homelessness in Palm Beach County (Ten-Year Plan). The need to reduce membership and change the direction of the Homeless Advisory Board (HAB) from one of plan development to a board whose focus is on implementation was identified. Resolution R2011-1233, approved by the BCC on August 16, 2011, reduces the membership from 36 to 19. Ms. Aigen has disclosed that she is employed by the Boca Raton Housing Authority that contracts with the County for CDBG funding. Mr. Gibson has disclosed that he is employed by The Lord's Place that contracts with the County for FAA funding to provide services to the homeless. The Homeless Advisory Board provides no regulation, oversight, management, or policy-setting recommendations regarding the Boca Raton Housing Authority or The Lord's Place contracts. Disclosure of these contractual relationships is being provided in accordance with the provisions of Sect. 2-443, of the Palm Beach County Code of Ethics. (Human Services) Countywide (TKF)

Background and Justification: The BCC formally adopted the Ten-Year Plan in September 2008. The Homeless Advisory Board's focus is now directed toward implementation, which is being aggressively pursued through its committees. Many of the members initially appointed were elected officials and chief executive officers. Due to the changing focus, the Homeless Advisory Board voted to revise the composition to reflect a board that is transition-oriented without designation of core or general membership categories. Member Categories have been developed to reflect the new HAB focus. The Division of Human Services provides staff support.

Jordan Hunt

Jordan Hunt is an experienced community leader who has advocated for the rights of the homeless in Palm Beach County for several years. Jordan began and continues to help organize the West Palm Beach chapter of Food Not Bombs. Since March of 2007, the group has been giving out free meals to the hungry and homeless in downtown West Palm. He has participated on several Homeless Advisory Board committees, including the Facilities, Funding, Community Outreach and Public Awareness, and Nominating committees.

Through the connections he has made working at The Breakers on Palm Beach, he was able to help coordinate The Breakers becoming involved with various service providers that deal with the issues of homelessness. These include weekly donations of leftover usable food to the Community Food Alliance, as well as providing food for Project Homeless Connect, and all of the old furnishings and artwork from recent room renovations have been donated to the Homeless Resource Center opening next year. Through his work on the COPA committee, Jordan had a major hand in organizing the new CHAT program — Community Homeless Awareness Tour - amongst which was getting The Breakers to donate the use of their shuttle for the tour.

In September of 2010 he joined the Board of Directors of the Homeless Coalition of Palm Beach County. Jordan looks forward to representing the Coalition on the Homeless Advisory Board and chairing the Policy and Legislation committee. For the future, Jordan is working with his brother Jason on opening a distribution microbrewery here in South Florida called Liquid Bakery Craft Brewery. He plans to stay involved with homeless outreach. As a business owner, he hopes to be able to use his resources to advance his goal of helping bring about a world with equality and well being for all.

Daniel Gibson, MSW Director of Programs The Lord's Place

Daniel Gibson was born and raised in Los Angeles, CA, and has been a Palm Beach County resident for eight years. He received his Bachelors in Psychology from Yale University, and his Masters in Social Work from Barry University. With over 15 years of experience in the social service field, Daniel brings a wealth of knowledge and expertise for program development, oversight and governance. Locally, Daniel has worked as a Case Manager and Counselor for youth in alternative education schools and the juvenile justice system. He also oversaw the Youth and Family Services Department for Compass, developing support programs for GLBT (Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, Transsexual) teens and parents, as well as HIV Education programming for teens throughout Palm Beach County. As a former Director of Community Impact at United Way of Palm Beach County, Daniel showcased a proven expertise at developing and overseeing community initiatives, coordinating community events around HIV prevention and education, foreclosure prevention, affordable housing, homelessness and food insecurity. He has been the Chair of the Palm Beach County Affordable Housing Collaborative, and in 2007 coordinated the first large-scale Foreclosure Prevention Symposium in South Florida, an event attended by over 500 individuals including the US Secretary of Housing and Urban Development. He also helped to write and introduce Palm Beach County's current Ten Year Plan to End Homelessness.

While at The Lord's Place, Daniel has become a recognized leader in the Palm Beach County's efforts to end homelessness. Since joining The Lord's Place team, he has developed and implemented an agency wide CQI (Continuous Quality Improvement) system, which provides the daily oversight and collection of program and organizational data. He provides direction and leadership for all twelve programs at The Lord's Place, including their highly respected supportive housing programs for families and individuals, and their newest job training and placement services for homeless and formerly homeless individuals. Daniel is driven by a passion for serving marginalized communities, especially populations who have experienced injustice, inequality and poverty. Most recently, Daniel has taken on a communitywide initiative for reentry services in Palm Beach County. He currently acts as the Project Director for the Transition from Jail to Community Project, a 31-agency collaborative that is helping to rehabilitate and reintegrate ex-offenders who are returning to our communities. Daniel recognizes that, in order for our communities to be safe and profitable, all citizens must have equal access to health, housing, employment and opportunity. Daniel believes that housing is a human right, not just a privilege, and he is proud to be a trusted champion for homeless and human rights.
