Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to continue: the Public Hearing for the Michlar Drive, Tamis Trail and 105th Avenue South Paving and Drainage (Project) assessment approval, Project No. 2002136 and the award of a contract with Rosso Paving and Drainage, Inc., from December 20, 2011, to January 24, 2012, at 9:30 AM.

SUMMARY: The Public Hearing was previously scheduled for December 20, 2011 to approve assessments and the award of a contract. This action was dependent however, on approval of the changes to the Municipal Services Taxing Unit Ordinance which was delayed until the January 24, 2012, meeting.

District 3 (MRE)

Background and Justification: On October 18, 2011, this item was presented to the Board of County Commissioners (Board); however it was continued to December 20, 2011, with direction from the Board to re-petition the property owners in order to obtain their input on the Project, prior to the December 20, 2011, Public Hearing. A positive response was obtained from the property owners, who were also advised the Project would be presented to the Board at the December 20, 2011 meeting. However, due to the extension of the first reading of the Ordinance change to the Municipal Services Taxing Unit Street Improvement Ordinance (Ordinance), upon which this item is also dependent, this item will be continued to January 24, 2012, after the second reading and approval of the Ordinance change.


