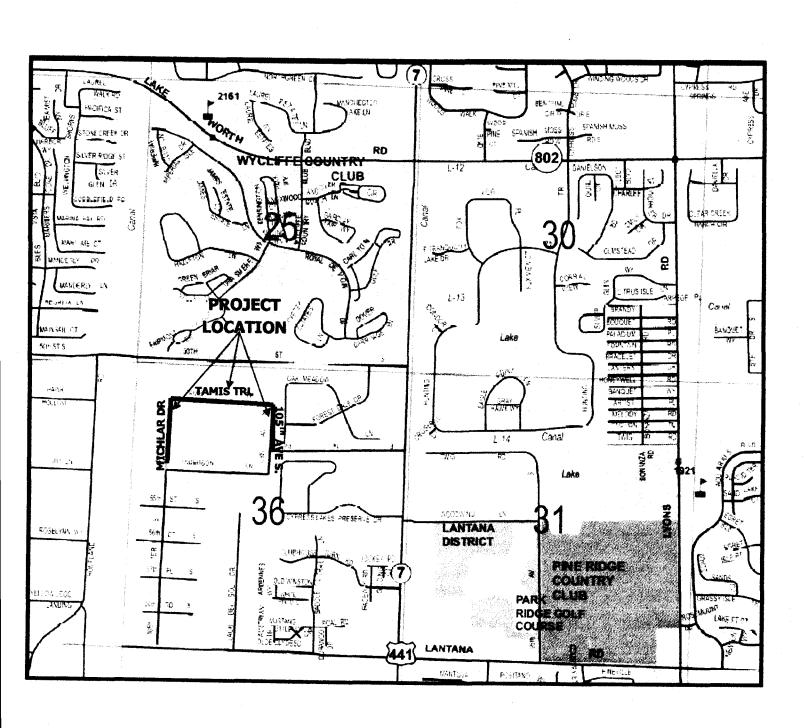

However, due to the extension of the first reading of the Ordinance change to the Municipal Services Taxing Unit Street Improvement Ordinance (Ordinance), upon which this item is also dependent, this item will be continued to January 24, 2012, after the second reading and approval of the Ordinance change. The Board also directed that the assessment be payable in 20 equal annual installments. The Project is located in Section 36, Township 44 South, Range 41 East. The bids were received by the Board on July 19, 2011.
