I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

MOTION AND TITLE: Staff recommends motion to approve: **(A)** The First Amendment to the Contract with Gulfstream Goodwill Industries, Inc. (R2011-1074) reducing the contract by \$26,428 to \$98,963; **(B)** The First Amendment to the Contract with The Lord's Place, Inc. (R2011-1075) reducing the contract by \$10,000 to \$207,995; **(C)** The First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with the City of Riviera Beach (R2011-1076) reducing the agreement by \$32,362 to \$133,030; and **(D)** The First Amendment to the Legal Services Agreement with the Public Defender's Office (R2100-1077) increasing the agreement by \$39,390 to \$136,790.

SUMMARY: Palm Beach County accepted a grant award of \$750,000 (Resolution Number- R-2010-1590) on July 19, 2011 from the Department of Justice to facilitate the successful reintegration of offenders as they return to the County from the Department of Corrections. Pre and post release services are delivered through a collaboration with service providers and the Florida Department of Corrections. The original term of the grant was for twelve months (ending in September 2011). A twelve month extension was granted that extends the term to twenty-four months (through September 2012). The contracts have been restructured based on project expenditures throughout the grant period. All other terms of the contracts, including expiration dates and scopes of work will remain unchanged. Countywide (PE).

BACKGROUND AND JUSTIFICATION: The vision of the RESTORE Initiative is to define a standard of excellence for offender transition that encourages correctional practitioners and community-based organizations to implement its various elements. The goal is to reduce the recidivism rate by 50% over 5 years for the target population (325 state prisoners returning to Palm Beach County through the Department of Corrections). The program is intended to reduce recidivism among transitioning offenders, reduce future victimization, enhance public safety and improve the lives of communities, victims and offenders.

A sub-committee of the Reentry Task Force issued a Request For Services, reviewed applications and selected Gulfstream Goodwill Industries, Inc., The Lord's Place, Inc. and The City of Riviera Beach to provide Case Management, Employment Services, Transitional Housing and Ex-Offender Support Services to include Drug Treatment, Peer Support Groups, Family Reunification Events, Literacy Classes, GED Classes and Trade Education and Certification. These amendments will reconcile the local grant budgets with the approved Department of Justice budget.

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INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, FLORIDA

THIS INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT is made the First day of May, 2011 by and between the Board of County Commissioners, Palm Beach County, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (herein referred to as the COUNTY), and the City of Riviera Beach, a municipality located in Palm Beach County, Florida (herein referred to as the CITY), each one constituting a public agency as defined in Part I of Chapter 163, Florida Statutes.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Section 163.01 of the Florida Statutes, known as the Florida Interlocal Cooperation Act of 1969, authorizes local governmental units to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate with other localities on a basis of mutual advantage and thereby to provide services and facilities in a manner and pursuant to forms of governmental organization that will harmonize geographic, economic, population and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities; and

WHEREAS, Part I of Chapter 163 of the Florida Statutes permits public agencies as defined therein to enter into interlocal agreements with each other to exercise jointly any power, privilege, or authority which such agencies share in common and which each might exercise separately; and

WHEREAS, the Criminal Justice Commission (CJC), received a Second Chance Act (SCA) grant from the Department of Justice in the amount of Seven Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$750,000); and

WHEREAS, the CITY has presented a proposal to initiate a partnership in accordance with the Regional and State Transitional Offender Reentry (RESTORE) Initiative; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY will reimburse the CITY for the expenses outlined in the Budget, Exhibit B, up to the amount of One Hundred Sixty Five Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars (\$165,392) from May 1, 2011 through September 30, 2012 for reentry efforts as outlined in the RESTORE Initiative and Scope of Work (Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS the CITY will provide services and expenditures in the targeted areas as set forth in Exhibits A and B.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual representations, terms and covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE and PAYMENT

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN **AMENDMENT** TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH AND THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, PALM BEACH COUNTY FOR THE FUNDING OF THE JUSTICE SERVICE CENTER REENTRY **GRANT** PROGRAM RESTORE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council, on July 6, 2011, approved an Interlocal Agreement with the Criminal Justice Commission of Palm Beach County to fund the Justice Service Center Regional and State Transitional Offender Reentry (RESTORE) Initiative; and

WHEREAS, the initial agreement included funding from the Criminal Justice Commission of Palm Beach County in the amount of \$165,392; and

WHEREAS, in December of 2011, the Criminal Justice Commission, in its efforts to meet program objectives, reduced the contract amount by \$32,362; and

WHEREAS, the city must execute an amendment to the Interlocal Agreement to comply with the budget change.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to execute the First Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Riviera Beach and the Board of County Commissioners, Palm Beach County for the Justice Service Center.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and approval by the City Council.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO LEGAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, in order to meet program objectives, the amount of the contract amount shall be increased by \$39,390; and

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises contained herein, the COUNTY and the OFFICE mutually agree that:

- 1. The total amount to be paid by the COUNTY under this contract for all services and materials shall not exceed a total contract amount of One Hundred Thirty Six Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$136,790) as detailed in Exhibit B, as attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. Exhibit B, as attached hereto, shall replace Exhibit B to the Agreement (R2011-1077).
- 3. All other provisions of said LEGAL SERVICES AGREEMENT are hereby confirmed, and except as provided herein are not otherwise altered or amended and remain in full force and effect.
