I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: A Contract with American Engineering & Development Corporation (American), the lowest responsive, responsible bidder in the amount of \$277,737.35 for the construction of Caroline Avenue Crossing Over Lake Worth Drainage District L-3 Canal (Project).

SUMMARY: Approval of this Contract will allow Palm Beach County (County) to issue a Notice to Proceed to American, a Palm Beach County company, to begin construction of the Project. The Palm Beach County Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for the Project is 15% overall. The SBE participation proposed for the Project by American is 17.07%.

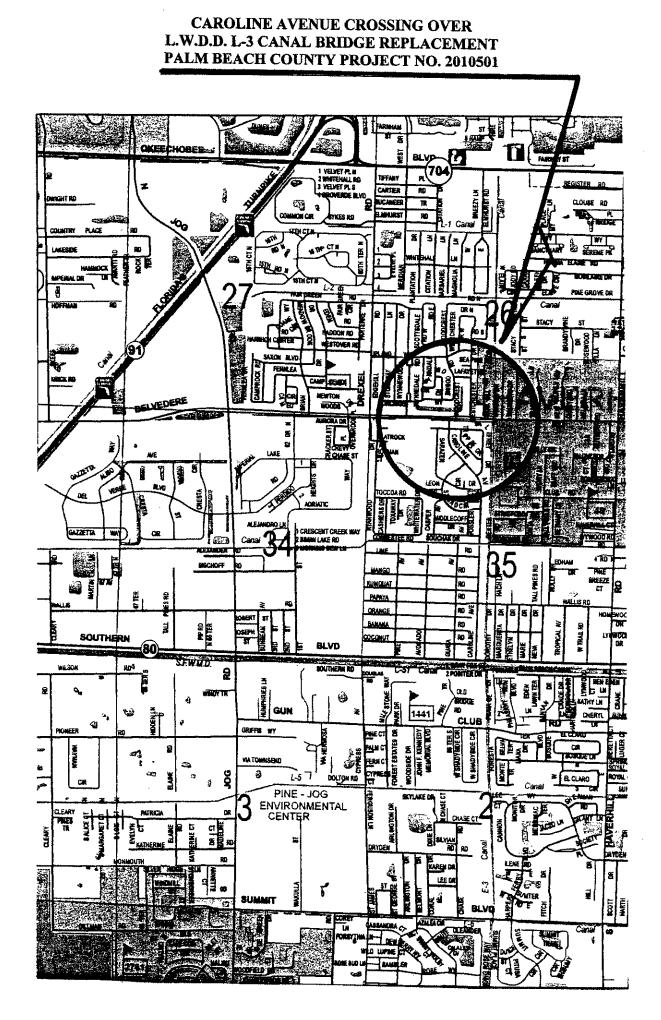

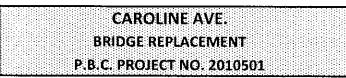
