## I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: STAFF RECOMMENDS MOTION TO APPROVE: Appointment of one (1) individual to the Contract Review Committee.

**Summary**: On December 6, 2011 the Board of County Commissioners voted to add an At-Large appointee to the Contract Review Committee. The Committee is currently comprised of three staff members, which consists of the County Attorney (or designee), the County Engineer (or designee) and the Director of Contract Development and Control (or designee) who serves as the Committee's Chair. The appointee by the Board will become the fourth member of the Committee, and serve a term of two years, at which time the appointee may be re-appointed, or a new appointee selected by the Board. The Board desires that the appointee be a representative from the community with general contracting experience or an attorney experienced in construction law. Mr. Cunningham is a local attorney who specializes in construction law. Countywide (JM)

Background and Justification: Per the direction and vote of the Board of County Commissioners on December 6, 2011, a fourth member of the Contract Review Committee shall be an At-Large appointee of the Board from the community with experience in general contracting or an attorney with experience in construction law. The Contract Review Committee meets weekly, and discusses and approves items brought forth by Lead and User Departments that effect changes to Board approved construction or design professional contracts. The Committee also votes on Final Contract Summaries in relation to construction projects. Mr. Cunningham is a local attorney admitted to practice in Florida, and he specializes in commercial and construction litigation.

## Curriculum Vitae F. Malcolm Cunningham, Jr.

**F. Malcolm Cunningham, Jr.**, is a native of Palm Beach County, Florida. He received his BA degree from Fisk University in Nashville, Tennessee in 1977 and his JD degree from Howard University in Washington, D.C., in 1980, where he served as Associate Editor of the Howard Law Journal. Following his graduation from Howard University, Mr. Cunningham served as a law clerk to the Honorable Joseph W. Hatchett, Circuit Judge, United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit (1980-81).

Admitted to practice law in Florida in 1980, Cunningham is an AV rated attorney. His practice is concentrated in commercial and construction litigation and he represents contractors, sureties, public owners, insurance companies and developers. Mr. Cunningham is recognized in the national legal community for professional achievement. Cunningham has served as a member of the governing committee of the ABA Forum on the Construction Industry. Additionally, he is a former Vice Chair of the ABA Tort and Insurance Practice Section's Fidelity and Surety Law Committee. Cunningham also served on the Council of the ABA Tort and Insurance Practice Section ("TIPS").

Mr. Cunningham has written for and lectured to trade associations and Bar groups including the Insurance Coverage Litigation Committee and the Fidelity and Surety Law Committee of TIPS on issues related to construction. Cunningham is the author of numerous papers and articles including F. Malcolm Cunningham, Jr. & Amy L. Fischer, Insurance Coverage in Construction-The Unanswered Question, 33 Tort & Ins. L.J. 1063 (Summer 1998) and The Ethical Considerations of Representing a Principal and a Surety, reprinted as Chapter 13 of the Bond Default Manual, Second Edition.

Cunningham has been active in business and politics in West Palm Beach. Cunningham is the managing partner of The Cunningham Law Firm, P.A. Cunningham is a former member of the Economic Council of Palm Beach County, Florida and is the former Chairman of the Palm Beach County Criminal Justice Commission. Cunningham also served on the board of the local district council for HRS.

Cunningham is a member of Tabernacle Missionary Baptist Church located in West Palm Beach. He is married to the former Pamela Jeffrey and has four children.
