# I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:** a Contract with R.J. Sullivan Corporation for the construction of a Vacuum Wastewater Pumping Facility in the amount of \$1,189,000 with an Alternate Bid of \$62,000 to serve the Belvedere Homes area. The contract is contingent upon approval by the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity.

Summary: On February 29, 2012, two (2) bids were received for the Belvedere Homes Infrastructure Improvements Vacuum Pump Station Building and Site Landscaping project, with R.J. Sullivan Corporation being the lowest responsive bidder in the amount of \$1,189,000 with an alternate bid of \$62,000 that includes a stainless steel tank to minimize maintenance cost along with electrical and site improvements. Palm Beach County Water Utilities Department (WUD) will administer the project for the Westgate/Belvedere Homes Community Redevelopment Agency. Funding for this project has been provided by Palm Beach County Department of Economic Sustainability (DES) under the Community Development Block Grant Program (\$985,400.00) and by WUD (\$203,600.00). This Project has participation goals of 22.4% MBE and 6.9% WBE per the "Equal Opportunity Clause" and "Standard Federal Equal Employment Specification" set forth in the Requirements for Federally Funded Projects Section of the Contract. The Contract with R.J. Sullivan Corporation includes 2.15% MBE. Although SBE participation is not required by the Contract, R.J. Sullivan Corporation provides an SBE participation of 14.97% overall. R.J. Sullivan Corporation is a Palm Beach County company. (WUD Project No. 10-502) District 2 (JM)

**Background and Justification:** This project is the complement of the Belvedere Homes Infrastructure Improvement project that includes the construction of a vacuum type sewer collection system. The Belvedere Homes Community is within the WUD's utility service area. Presently central wastewater service is available to only a minority of the properties. Together with the proposed vacuum sewer collection system, this project will make wastewater service available to the Belvedere Homes residents. This project must be completed by December 15, 2012.



The bid opening for the above referenced project was held on Wednesday, February 29, 2012. Proposals were received from two (2) contractors. The complete Bid Tabulation is attached. The Engineer's opinion of probable construction cost was \$1,300,000.00. The construction cost is \$1,189,000.00 for the base bid and \$62,000.00 for the alternate bid. An evaluation of the low bid by R J Sullivan Corporation is as follows:

- 1. The Bid Form provided in the Contract Documents was properly executed.
- 2. Bid security equal to 5% of the total base bid was enclosed with the bid.
- 3. M/WBE Contractor/Subcontractor Participation and M/WBE Supplier Participation were provided. The bid documents state a 22.4% minority participation goal and a 6.9% female participation goal established by the U.S. Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration (EDA) grant. The goal is in terms of the Contractor's aggregate workforce in each trade on all construction work. See attached M/WBE Evaluation spreadsheets. R J Sullivan Corporation provided 2.00% M/WBE participation utilizing workforce personnel and 1.11% participation utilizing SBE participation. See attached Schedule 2 and 2 from R J Sullivan Corporation regarding M/WBE and SBE participation.
- 4. The lowest responsive bidder acknowledged one (1) addenda.
- The contractor holds a valid state and County contractor's license. A copy of the license information is included. Although the Local Preference Ordinance is not applicable to this EDA funded project, the low bidder is a local company and

has estimated that 75% of the work will be performed by local Palm Beach County companies.

The overall experience, qualifications, resources and references of the low bidder were carefully considered when evaluating the bids. Contract award is recommended to the lowest responsive bidder, R J Sullivan Corporation Company of Florida, in the amount not to exceed \$1,189,000.00 for the base bid, subject to formal approval by the PBC Board of County Commissioners. A copy of this notice has been posted at the bid opening location and will be left there for a minimum of five (5) business days.

The request should be accompanied by a full statement of the interested party's position and by any information (wage payment data, project description, area practice material, etc.) that the requestor considers relevant to the issue.

3.) If the decision of the Administrator is not favorable, an interested party may appeal directly to the Administrative Review Board (formerly the Wage Appeals Board). Write to:

4.) All decisions by the Administrative Review Board are final.
