I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to

- A) approve Amendment Number 1 to the Tri Party Agreement with the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections and Dominion Voting Systems, Inc. (R-2011-1536), providing for WinEDS 4.0, Insight Firmware, Edge upgrade to version 5.2.16 and 400C Firmware software upgrades in an amount not to exceed \$117,450; and
- B) approve a Budget Transfer \$844,450 to the General Fund Contingency Reserves for funds previously allocated for the purchased of Supervisor of Election's software and hardware upgrades and support services; and
- **C)** approve a downward Budget Amendment of \$844,450 to reduce the transfer from the General Fund for this project.

Summary: On October 4, 2011, the Board of County Commissioners approved a Tri Party Agreement with the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections (SOE) and Dominion Voting Systems, Inc. (Dominion) in the amount of \$961,900 for the development and purchase of Insight Listener software and the purchase of related modems for the purpose of receiving vote totals by modem from the Insight ballot counters in the precincts. In conducting field visits to some of the County's polling locations, the SOE discovered that a number of them had digital telephone lines that did not accommodate analog modems. As a result of the field visits, the SOE and Dominion desire to amend the Agreement to substitute the WinEDS 4.0, Insight Firmware, Edge upgrade to version 5.2.16 and 400C Firmware upgrade in the not to exceed amount of \$117,450, and delete the modems as originally agreed to. Countywide (DW)

Background and Justification: In the original Tri Party Agreement (R-2011-1536) with the SOE and Dominion, per the request of the SOE, Dominion was to develop and provide software and related modems for the purpose of receiving vote totals by modem from ballot counters in the precincts. As a result of field visits to some of the County's polling locations the SOE discovered that the phone systems at some locations did not accommodate the modems purchased under the Agreement. Due to the challenges associated with the digital phone systems and the Insight modems upgrade previously purchased, the scope of the original Agreement is being altered by eliminating the Insight modem upgrade and continuing with the WinEDS 4.0, Insight firmware, Edge upgrade to version 5.2.16 and 400C Firmware upgrade. The upgraded voting system will be operated in conjunction with remote tally centers. On-site training and election day support will be provided by Dominion.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR INSIGHT LISTENER SOFTWARE AND RELATED MODEMS

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT, dated April 3, 2012, to Contract No. R-2011-1536, dated October 4, 2011, by and between Palm Beach County Board of Commissioners, having its principal place of business at 301 North Olive Avenue, West Palm Beach, Florida 33401, ("COUNTY") the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections ("SOE"), located at 240 South Military Trail, West Palm Beach, Florida 33415 ("SOE") (collectively referred to as "Customer") and Dominion Voting Systems, Inc., having its principal place of business at 1201 18th Street, Suite 210, Denver, Colorado 80202 ("Dominion").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the parties have entered into that certain Agreement dated October 4, 2011, hereinafter referred to as the "AGREEMENT" for the purchase of Insight Listener Software and related modems; and

WHEREAS, in conducting field visits to some of COUNTY'S polling locations, the SOE discovered that a number of polling locations have digital telephone lines that do not accommodate analog modems; and

WHEREAS, based on the challenges associated with the Insight modem upgrade, the SOE terminated the AGREEMENT with Dominion as it relates to the purchase of modems; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the AGREEMENT to Contract for the WinEDS 4.0, Insight Firmware, Edge Upgrade to Version 5.2.16, and 400C Firmware Upgrade pursuant to Exhibit A attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY shall pay invoices in a timely manner pursuant to the invoicing schedule described in Exhibit A in an amount not to exceed \$117,450.00.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements expressed herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The AGREEMENT is hereby amended to delete any and all reference to the purchase of the Insight modem upgrade as well as all references to Exhibit B. Further, the parties agree that the WinEDS 4.0, Insight Firmware, Edge Upgrade to Version 5.2.16, and 400C Firmware upgrade, as well as onsite training and all Election Day support as described in Exhibit A attached to this Amendment shall be the sole basis for this AGREEMENT.
- COUNTY'S Payment and Related Responsibilities is hereby amended as follows:
 COUNTY shall pay invoices in a timely manner pursuant to the invoicing schedule described in Exhibit A in an amount not to exceed \$117,450.00.
- Paragraphs 7, 8 and 10 through 40 of said CONTRACT, dated October 4, 2011, are hereby confirmed and, except as provided herein, are not otherwise altered or amended and shall remain in full force and effect.
- 4. This FIRST AMENDMENT shall not take effect until executed by the parties hereto.
