#### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

#### Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- A) A Contract with The Murphy Construction, Co. (Murphy), the lowest responsive, responsible bidder in the amount of \$966,784.00 for the construction of 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue North Bridge Over Keller Canal (Project); and
- **B)** A Budget Transfer of \$150,000 in the Road Program Sweeps Reserve and appropriate it to the Project's account.

**SUMMARY:** Approval of this Contract and Budget Transfer will allow Palm Beach County (County) to issue a Notice to Proceed to Murphy, a Palm Beach County company, to begin construction of the Project. The Palm Beach County Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for all project is 15% overall. The SBE participation proposed for the Project by Murphy is 17.09%.

**Background and Justification:** Bids for the Project were received by the Engineering Department on March 6, 2012. Murphy was the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. The Office of Small Business Assistance issued its evaluation on March 27, 2012. Time to complete all work under this contract shall be no more than 210 calendar days.

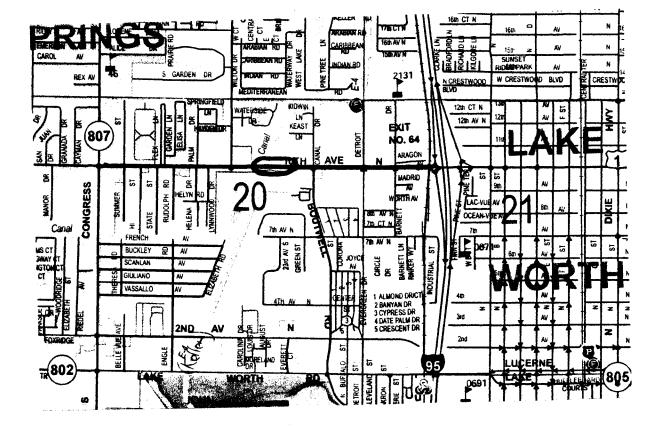

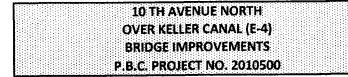
