I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Title: Palm Beach County Special Assessments Programs including: The Municipal Services Taxing Unit (MSTU) Program and the Water Utilities Special Assessment (WUSA) Program

Summary: The County manages two (2) separate assessment programs. The MSTU Program provides for the construction of road improvements, storm drainage, driveways, earthwork, traffic control, and landscaping for unimproved areas within unincorporated Palm Beach County and is managed by the Engineering Department. The WUSA Program provides for the construction of potable water, wastewater and/or reclaimed water facilities for areas desiring those services within Water Utilities Service Area and is managed by the Water Utilities Department. Currently, the Programs have varying criteria. It is the desire of County Staff to align these Programs as close as feasibly possible. Staff is seeking Board direction concerning:

- 1. The process to be utilized to initiate the Assessment Programs;
- 2. The determination of citizen support;
- 3. Assessment process
- 4. The required repayment amount (%);
- 5. The number of years required for repayment;
- 6. The interest rate for repayment balance;
- 7. Approval to begin accepting new applications for MSTU Program; and
- 8. Determine acceptable sources of funding for the MSTU Program.

Countywide (ME/MJ)

Background and Policy Issues: The MSTU Program is established by the MSTU Special Assessment Ordinance No. 94-11, as amended by Ordinance No. 95-53, 2008-063 and 2012-002. The WUSA Program was established by Ordinance No. 2001-010. The County's WUSA Program is currently active with six (6) ongoing projects in varying stages of the process. The Board directed Staff not to accept any new applications for the MSTU Program on July 22, 2008. Currently, the MSTU Fund has approximately \$6.9 Million available of which \$4.7 Million will fund the previously approved projects including Whispering Pines, M Canal Bridge, and Palm Beach Ranchettes. The remaining \$2.2 Million is available to fund new projects. New projects could also be funded from bond financing in accordance with F.S. 125.01(1)(r).

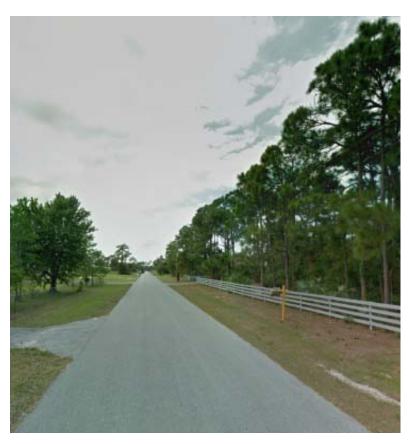
Currently active

MSTU PROGRAM STATUS:
