I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve:

- A) A 60 calendar day contract (Contract) with Seacoast, Inc. (Contractor), the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder, in the amount of \$1,306,379.24 for the CR707 Bascule Bridge Machine Room Repairs (Project); and
- B) Supplement No. 2 for \$46,950.00 to the task authorization approved by Resolution No. R2011-0174 on February 15, 2011, with Bridge Design Associates, Inc. (Consultant) for additional engineering services for shop drawing reviews, periodic site visits and reports, initial and final monitoring of balance tests, semi-final and final inspection and attendance at meetings.

SUMMARY: Approval of this Contract will allow the repair or replacement of various sub-structure steel and concrete items associated with the operation of the lift span. Approval of Supplement No. 2, with Palm Beach County's annual structural engineering Consultant will provide additional engineering services. The Contractor is a Pinellas County business and was the sole bidder. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) goal for the Project is 15%. The Contractor has no SBE participation committed for the Project. The Contractor has performed some on site value engineering and determined that rather than closing the bridge to traffic for the 60 day contract period, he could perform the necessary work over the 60 day period with eight separate night closures. The 60 day Contract time will start only after all of the required parts have been ordered and received. We estimate the contract and the associated night time closures may start sometime after October 1, 2012.

Background and Justification: The bids were received by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) on February 14, 2012. Only one bid was received however, the Contractor's expertise for working on bascule bridges is well documented in Palm Beach County as well as other areas in and out of the State of Florida.

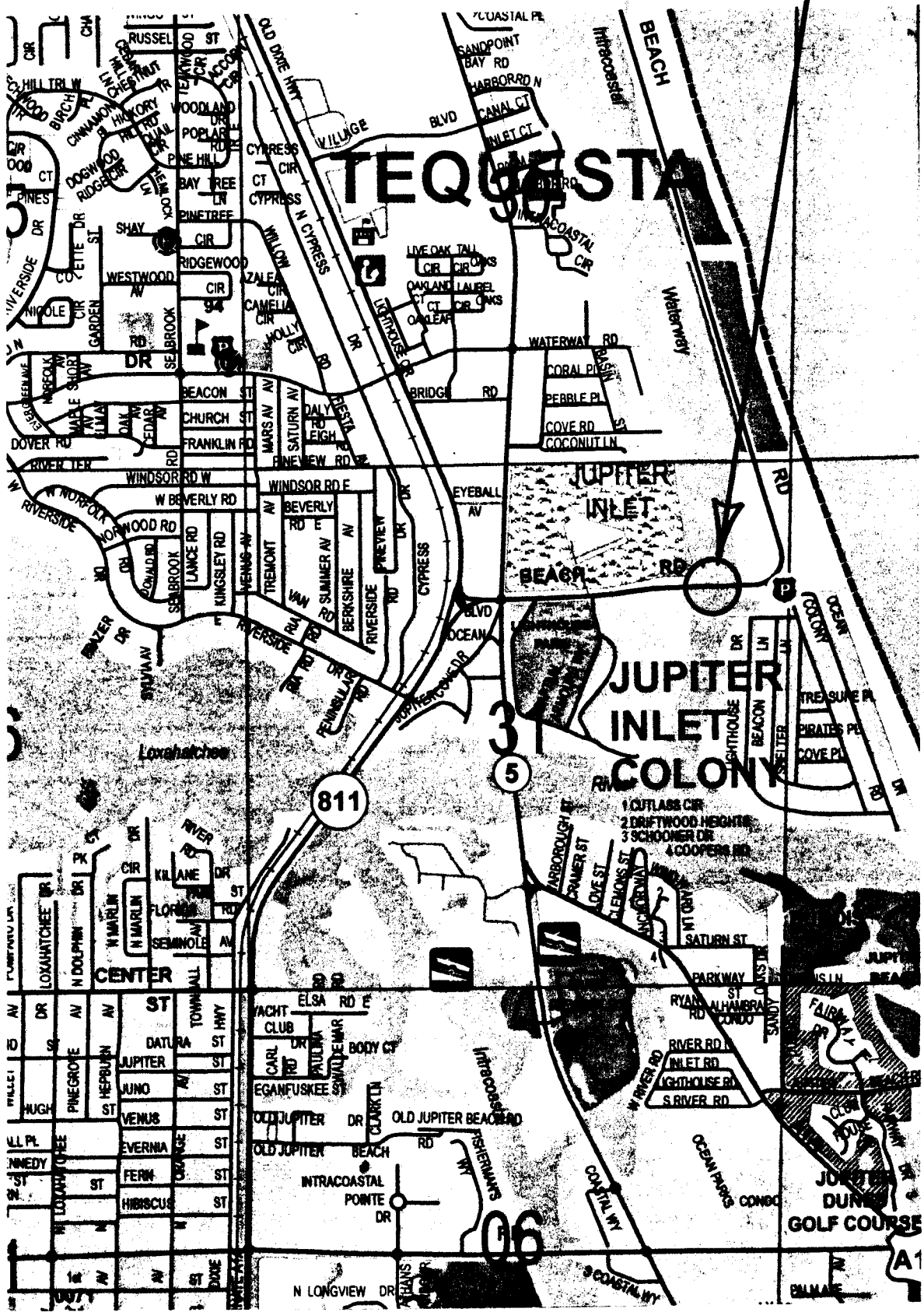

Background and Justification: (Continued from Page 1)

Through the Contractor's value engineering of the project, the duration of the bridge closure is greatly reduced. During the nights that the bridge is closed, the Palm Beach Sheriff's Office and Fire Rescue will be stationed on the island side of the bridge. Due to the Contractor's repair procedure, there will be a cost savings by the elimination of a Water Taxi, and reduction in man hours for emergency responders. Residents, service personnel and the general public will not be inconvenienced by loss of vehicular access to and from the island. Supplement No. 2 to the task authorization will include shop drawing reviews, periodic site visits and reports, initial and final monitoring of balance tests, semi-final and final inspection and attendance at meetings.

After commencement of the work, it shall be properly dispatched toward completion, to the satisfaction of the Engineer, and shall be fully completed within the time limit. It is understood and agreed that the time limit for completion of said work is the essence of the contract and should the contractor fail to complete the work within the time limit, it is agreed that for such calendar day that any work provided for in these Contract Documents shall remain incomplete after the time limit has expired, including any official extension of the time limit; the sum per day given in the contained schedules shall be deducted from monies due the Contractor, not as a penalty, but as liquidated damages and added expense for supervision.
