RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA TO UTILIZE A PORTION OF THE COUNTY VESSEL REGISTRATION FEES FOR CONSTRUCTING THE PHIL FOSTER SNORKEL REEF TRAIL AND PEANUT ISLAND ARTIFICIAL REEF PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County enacted the Vessel Registration Fee Ordinance, No. 88-40 which began collecting fees June 1, 1989; and

WHEREAS, the Vessel Registration Fee Ordinance provides that monies collected from vessel registration fees be utilized to protect coastal marine and estuarine habitats, maintain and enhance fisheries and other salt and freshwater habitats, and construct artificial reefs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners support the restoration and enhancement of the Lake Worth Lagoon including the construction of artificial reefs; and

WHEREAS, a snorkel reef trail is planned along the south shore of Phil Foster Park consisting of approximately 500 tons to limestone rock and concrete materials placed in 6-10' of water to act as a snorkel trail; and

WHEREAS, a portion of rock along the southeast corner of Peanut Island will be relocated to the eastern face of the island to act as breakwaters and artificial reefs and which will improve flushing into the snorkel reef basin, provide protection to the beach and create additional opportunities for snorkelers; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Environmental Resources Management recommends that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the Clerk of the Court to disburse Vessel Registration Fee monies in the amount of \$200,000 for the Phil Foster Snorkel Reef Trail and Peanut Island Artificial Reef Projects.
