Summary: The Impact Fee Review Committee is composed of seven members and three alternate members appointed by the BCC. The membership of the committee includes three representatives from municipalities, three representatives from the business community, and one member selected at large. The alternate members include one representative from each of the categories above.

Robert Gottlieb's appointment would fill a vacancy on the Impact Fee Review Committee created by a member resignation in 2011.

Scott Worley is currently serving on the Impact Fee Review Committee as an alternate member. A regular seat vacancy was created with the recent resignation of Joe Pollock. This agenda item would allow Scott Worley to complete Joe Pollock's unexpired term on the Committee as a regular seat appointee. Countywide (LB)

Background and Policy Issues: Article 2 of the Unified Land Development Code provides for an Impact Fee Review Committee. Impact Fee Review Committee members must be qualified electors of Palm Beach County for two years prior to appointment.

Robert Gottlieb resigned from the Impact Fee Review Committee February 2011 for personal reasons. Mr. Gottlieb is now able to serve again and has been nominated by the League of Cities to fill the vacant municipal seat.

Scott Worley currently serves as an alternate member on the Impact Fee Review Committee. Alternate members attend Committee meetings but only count toward the quorum or vote on issues if a regular member of the same seat category is absent from the meeting. Approval of this agenda item would allow Scott Worley to serve as a regular member in the seat vacated by Joe Pollock's resignation.

## Section II Communea:

**CONTRACTUAL RELATIONSHIPS:** Pursuant to Article XIII, Sec. 2-443 of the Palm Beach County Code of Ethics, advisory board members are prohibited from entering into any contract or other transaction for goods or services with Palm Beach County. Exceptions to this prohibition include awards made under sealed competitive bids, certain emergency and sole source purchases, and transactions that do not exceed \$500 per year in aggregate. These exemptions are described in the Code. This prohibition does not apply when the advisory board member's board provides no regulation, oversight, management, or policy-setting recommendations regarding the subject contract or transaction and the contract or transaction is disclosed at a public meeting of the Board of County Commissioners. To determine compliance with this provision, it is necessary that you, as a board member applicant, identify all contractual relationships between Palm Beach County government and you as an individual, directly or indirectly, or your employer or business. This information should be provided in the space below. If there are no contracts or transactions to report, please verify that none exist. Staff will review this information and determine if you are eligible to serve or if you may be eligible for an exception or waiver pursuant to the code.

Scott Worley start his building career in the mid 1980 in New York City as Vice President of Timko Contracting where he was involved with the construction of over 6,000 high rise apartments and more than 1 million square footage of commercial space. Mr. Worley was also the President of Franconia Development Corporation, a real estate developer of commercial and residential properties in New Hampshire.

Upon first moving to Palm Beach County in 1992, Scott worked for the South Florida regional residential home builder Levitt Homes as a Vice President where he was involved in the development, construction and sale of several thousand homes in multiple residential communities.

In the late 1990's Scott became partner with David Ettinger in ownership of Northstar Homes where he acted as Chief Operating Officer and General Contractor. Northstar Homes was a residential community homebuilder that constructed over 2,500 homes in a dozen communities in Palm Beach County. Communities developed during the time period that Scott Worley was Chief Operating Officer include Avalon Estates, Cascade Lakes, Tuscany Village, Gramercy Square and Cobblestone Creek.

Scott Worley has been an active member of Gold Coast Builder Association especially in the area of Governmental Affairs where he has been devoted to promoting the housing industry in Palm Beach County. He was the President of Gold Coast Builders Association in 2008, was named Builder of the Year in 2005 and inducted into the Hall of Fame in 2010.

Scott Worley has been appointed by the Palm Beach County Commissioners to the Palm Beach County Building Code Advisory Board where he has served as the Chairperson of the Board.

Scott Worley has also been appointed by the Palm Beach County Commissioners to the Palm Beach County – Land Development Regulations Advisory Board.

Mr. Worley graduated from Lehigh University in Bethlehem Pennsylvania and has a CPA license (inactive) in Pennsylvania. He started his career working for the CPA firm Arthur Young in New York City. He has been happily married for the past 25 years to his wife Christina and together they have threes sons in Michael, Robert and Derek.

Scott Worley is still actively building homes in Palm Beach County currently under the name of Vintage Homes at the Lakes, LLC. He maintains a Florida general contracting license CGC1504252 and a Florida Real Estate Salesperson license.

The IFAB shall be composed of five members. There shall be one traffic engineer, one accountant, one attorney, one representative of the general public, and one developer/builder on the IFAB. No member of the Impact Fee Review Committee may serve on the IFAB.

#### b. Appointment

The members of the IFAB shall be approved at large by a majority vote of the BCC.

#### c. Terms of Office

All IFAB members shall serve a term of three years.

#### 4. Secretary and Staff

The Impact Fee Coordinator shall serve as Secretary of the IFAB. The staff of PZB shall be the professional staff of the IFAB. County Attorney shall attend meetings to serve as counsel to the IFAB. The Impact Fee Coordinator shall represent PBC by presenting PBC's position to the IFAB.

#### 5. Meetings

- a. General
  - General meetings of the IFAB will be called as necessary to carry out business, but no more frequently than once a month. Special meetings may be called by the Chair of the IFAB, or in writing by a majority of appointed members of the Board. Staff shall provide 24-hour written notice to each IEAB member for a special meeting.
  - to each IFAB member for a special meeting.

# J. Impact Fee Review Committee

- 1. Establishment
  - There is hereby created an Impact Fee Review Committee (IFRC).

#### 2. Powers and Duties

- The IFRC shall have the following powers and duties under the provisions of this Code:
- a. submit a Report to the BCC whenever PBC conducts a full review or update of the impact fee system relating to:
  - 1) the implementation of Article 13, IMPACT FEES;
  - 2) actual levels of service for the impact fees exacted in Article 13, IMPACT FEES;
  - the collection, encumbrance, and expenditure of all impact fees collected pursuant to Article 13, IMPACT FEES;
  - 4) the validity and assumptions in the technical memoranda used to support the impact fee schedules in Article 13, IMPACT FEES; and
  - 5) any recommended amendment to Article 13, IMPACT FEES.
- b. review amendments to Article 13, IMPACT FEES prior to their consideration by the BCC.
- c. perform such other duties as the BCC deems appropriate.

#### 3. Board Membership

#### a. Qualifications

The IFRC shall be composed of seven members and three alternate members appointed by the BCC. The membership of the IFRC shall include three representatives from municipalities within PBC, three representatives from the business community, and one member selected at large. The voting membership of the IFRC shall include three representatives from municipalities within PBC three representatives from the business community, and one member selected at large. The alternate members shall include one representative from each of the three categories above. An alternate member shall be authorized to vote in place of an absent voting member appointed from the same category and shall count toward a quorum.

## 4. Officers

#### a. Secretary

The Impact Fee Coordinator shall serve as Secretary of the IFRC.

#### 5. Meetings

#### a. General or Special Meetings

General meetings of the IFRC shall be held as needed consistent with its powers and duties. Special meetings may be called by the Chair of the IFRC, or in writing by a majority of appointed members of the IFRC. 24-hour written notice shall be given to each IFRC member for a special meeting.

## K. Planning Commission

- 1. Establishment
  - There is hereby established a Planning Commission (PLC). [Ord. 2008-003]

### 2. Powers and Duties

- a. to serve as the Local Planning Agency (LPA) per F.S.§ 163.3174, and to provide recommendations on the preparation of the Plan, or any element or portion thereof, and any text
