### I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

**Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: A)** use of County park properties in support of the Palm Beach County World Championship Offshore Grand Prix Powerboat Races to be held October 17, 2012, through October 22, 2012; and **B)** Agreement with Powerboater Palm Beach, LLC to conduct the Palm Beach County World Championship Offshore Grand Prix.

**Summary:** Powerboater Palm Beach, LLC would like to conduct a for-profit event, the Palm Beach County World Championship Offshore Grand Prix Powerboat Races, using Carlin Park and portions of Burt Reynolds Park, Ocean Cay Park, Loggerhead Park, and Juno Beach Park and its pier. This event requires a special events contract. In accordance with Chapter 21, Article II of the Palm Beach County Code, all requests for use of reserved park/facility areas for for-profit activities require Board approval. Powerboater Palm Beach, LLC must meet all requirements and pay all fees associated with event coordination at Carlin Park and other affected properties. The Palm Beach County Sports Commission has endorsed the event via a sponsorship and estimates a possible \$4 million economic impact to Palm Beach County garnishing national attention. The Parks and Recreation Department should receive an estimated \$16,416 in revenue for use of the County parks and staff coordination of this event. District 1 (AH)

Background and Policy Issues: Chapter 21 Article II of the Palm Beach County Code outlines park utilization regulations and commercial activities allowed within the park system. In accordance with the Code, all permits for for-profit events must be approved by the Board. Powerboater Palm Beach, LLC desires usage of five County parks for use as event parking, special event, concert, and as a day pit area from October 17, 2012, through October 21, 2012, for the Palm Beach County World Championship Offshore Grand Prix Powerboat Races. Powerboat races will take place on Friday, October 19 and Sunday, October 21, 2012. Saturday, October 20, 2012, will be utilized as a special event day for event patrons to see race boats up close on dry land. Powerboater Palm Beach, LLC shall meet all permit requirements and pay all fees associated with event coordination. The special event contract requires the compliance with rules and regulations of multiple regulatory agencies, municipalities, and law enforcement organizations, and addresses vehicular traffic patterns, pedestrian traffic, adequate waste control, and parking. The Parks and Recreation Department will utilize the contract process to minimize event impacts and to ensure a successful event for the benefit of County residents.

### PARKS RENTAL AGREEMENT FOR PALM BEACH COUNTY PARKS & RECREATION DEPARTMENT

This Agreement is made as of the	day of	, 20, by and be	tween Palm Beach	County, a
Political Subdivision of the State	of Florida, by and	through its Board of	Commissioners, h	ereinafter
referred to as the "County" and	Powerboater Palm	Beach, LLC, hereina	after referred to as	"Renter",
whose address is 755 Garden Roa	ad, Suite A, Riviera E	Beach, FL 33404.		

### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Renter has applied to conduct the Palm Beach County World Championship Offshore Grand Prix (Event) utilizing Carlin Park east and west, and portions of Juno Beach Park and Pier, Ocean Cay Park, Loggerhead Park, and the boat ramps at Burt Reynolds Park ("Park Properties") via the Special Events Application (Application), attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, Renter has the knowledge, ability, and equipment to provide such an event; and

WHEREAS, providing community events within County parks serves a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, both parties desire to enter into this Agreement.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises contained herein, the County and Renter hereby agree as follows:

- 1. **Recitals:** The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. <u>Term</u>: The Renter shall commence rental on Wednesday, October 17, 2012 at 8:00 AM and shall complete all services by Monday, October 22, 2012 at 8:00 PM for the purpose of an offshore boat race, concert, and special event as more particularly described in Exhibit "B", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, and for no other purpose whatsoever without the prior written consent of the County.
- 3. Payments To County: Renter shall pay a fee to the County estimated at \$16,416.00 for facilities and services. Renter shall also pay additional charges accrued for additional services, such as custodial, maintenance overtime, security and any other special requirements as more particularly described in Exhibit "C", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The total rental fee and any costs incurred by the County on behalf of the Renter shall be due at settlement, fourteen working days before the setup of the event and determined using a Rental Settlement Form as detailed in Exhibit "D", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

### 4. <u>Performance</u>:

- a) Renter agrees to:
  - 1. comply with all rules and regulations and adhere to all federal, state and local laws and regulations, County ordinances including, but not limited to, Chapter 21 of the Palm Beach County Code, pertaining to Parks and Recreation, and Department standard operating procedures as all such laws, regulations, ordinances, and procedures apply to Renter's use of Park Properties and Amenities as described in Exhibit "B".
  - 2. **return** Park Properties and Amenities and all equipment and improvements related to the rental to the condition existing as of the effective date and time specified in Article 2 above;

- 3. assume full responsibility for obtaining all licenses and permits required by Copyright Regulations of Title 17 of the United States Code and agrees to indemnify County and its agents for any expenses incurred as a result of Renter's failure to obtain such licenses or permits, including, but not limited to, fines or damages collected against County or COUNTY's agents, any attorney's fees and court costs, and for any expenses incurred as a result of Renter's failure to otherwise satisfy said regulations;
- 4. **remove** all equipment and materials owned by Renter and subcontractors no later than the termination date and time specified in Article 2 above;
- 5. **deliver** to the Department, no later than forty-eight (48) hours prior to the move-in of the Event, a copy of any and all required specialty certifications, licenses and or memberships applicable to the event, all of which will be retained by the Palm Beach County Parks and Recreation Department ("Department"), failure to deliver such required documentation may result in immediate termination of this Agreement which includes a demand for payment of all expenses incurred in association with this Agreement payable as liquidated damages, not penalty;
- assume all responsibility for event promotions, which is subject to the review and approval of County.
- 7. **prohibit** any activity on Park Properties that may be considered contrary to community standards of appropriateness;
- 8. **assure** that all persons under Renter's control conduct themselves in a socially acceptable manner:
- 9. **Use** the Park Properties and Amenities solely for the purpose for which this Agreement is entered into;
- 10. **accept** the Park Properties and Amenities and all equipment and improvements related to the rental in the condition existing as of the date of this Agreement;
- 11. **waive** any and all claims for compensation for any and all losses or damages sustained due to failure or malfunction of the water or electrical power supplies located on Park Properties and within the Amenities;
- 12. **follow** the directives of the Department's representatives including, but not limited to, the proper use and handling of County owned equipment, the assignment of designated parking areas, and the locations acceptable for offloading and staging of equipment and supplies;
- 13. **obtain** the Department's written approval prior to the use of any type of pyrotechnics;
- 14. **obtain** the Department's written approval prior to operating any engine, motor or machinery or using any flammable agents, including but not limited to oils, camphene, kerosene, naphtha, or gasoline; and
- 15. **hold** County harmless for the sale or disposal of any equipment and materials considered to be abandoned due to Renter's failure to remove same from the premises by the specified termination date and time and pay the cost of such removal and disposal upon receipt of invoice.

- b) County agrees to:
  - assign sufficient staff to provide logistical support and oversee all aspects of the rental including authority to make final decisions and issue directives on behalf of the County;
  - provide equipment and support services including law enforcement, technical staff and skilled maintenance, to be paid for by the Renter, as specified on Exhibit "B", and agreed to in advance by the Department;
  - retain control of Park Properties and all operations conducted on County property including enforcement of all laws, rules, and regulations pertaining to the safety and wellbeing of the public and protecting Park Properties and Amenities; and
  - 4. collect and dispose of any and all items either discarded or lost by patrons or others at the Event, without interference by Renter or any person working for or on behalf of Renter, the disposition of which may include retaining such items at a lost-and-found location.
- 5. Postponement or Cancellation of Event: In the event emergency conditions arise which may affect public safety, Renter's use of Park Properties and Amenities may be postponed or cancelled. Such emergency conditions include, but are not limited to, thunderstorms, lightening, hurricanes, tornadoes, or flooding. County, in its sole discretion, will determine the necessity to postpone or cancel Renter's use of Park Properties and Amenities and will endeavor to provide Renter at least four (4) hours notice prior to the Event's start time. Provided, however, County's notice to postpone or cancel the Event may be given at anytime including during the Event.

In the event County cancels Renter's use of Park Properties and Amenities due to any public safety concern, the term of this Agreement will be extended upon the same terms and conditions provided that within five (5) business days following such cancellation, County and Renter agree upon a rescheduled event date. Such term extension will be effective without amendment or any other further action.

- 6. <u>Cancellation for Cause</u>: The occurrence of any one or more of the following acts constitutes a material default and breach of this Agreement by Renter and will result in cancellation of Renter's use of the Park Properties and Amenities:
  - a. Renter elects to cancel the Event rather than accept the delayed start time ordered by County due to a public safety concern;
  - b. Renter fails to agree upon a rescheduled Event date within five (5) business days following County's cancellation of the Event due to a public safety concern;
  - c. Renter cancels due to illness;
  - d. Renter misrepresents its intended use of Park Properties and Amenities including acting as a broker or agent by attempting to re-let Park Properties and Amenities;
  - e. Renter's use of Park Properties and Amenities expands beyond the scope and purpose for which this Agreement is entered into;
  - f. Renter provided materially false information relating to this Agreement;
  - g. Any person under the control of Renter, including subcontractors, is responsible for purposely damaging Park Property or any County owned equipment; or
  - h. Any person under the control of Renter, including subcontractors, is guilty of gross misconduct or unlawful behavior while on Park Premises.

- i. Cancellation of this Agreement due to any such material default or breach requires Renter to pay any and all County expenses associated with Renter's use of Park Properties and Amenities together with all fees and charges due and owed the same as if Renter's use of Park Properties and Amenities had not been cancelled and the Event occurred as scheduled. County will not be held liable for any lost profits or damages resulting from any such cancellation. Renter's Booking Deposit will be applied to the expenses, fees and charges owed to County and any remaining balance owed is due and payable upon Renter's receipt of the Department's invoice.
- 6. Photography / Recording: Except for event performances and materials covered by copyright laws, licensing fees or other legal regulations, County may photograph and/or record audio and video of the Event. Such photos and recordings may be used by County for promotional and informational purposes only. County will provide advance notice to Renter of its intent to photograph and/or record during the Event and Renter agrees to provide assistance as needed to accommodate such photography and recording. Renter is responsible for being aware of and advising County of any copyright infringements or other legal limitations that may apply to photographing and/or recording during the Event.
- 7. Relationship of the Parties: Renter is an independent contractor and operator responsible for its acts and omissions, for which County cannot be held liable.

This Agreement does not constitute an endorsement or sponsorship by County of Renter or of Renter's use of Park Properties and Amenities. Though County may issue press releases and publish announcements regarding Renter's use of Park Properties and Amenities, including postings on County websites and social media sites, such announcements are intended solely for the purpose of raising awareness of Park Property and are not to be misrepresented as a form of endorsement or sponsorship by County.

Renter may not use the name or logo of the County, the Department or Amphitheater in a manner that suggests a relationship other than lessor and lessee. Any use of the County, Department or Amphitheater logos is subject to approval by the County.

- 8. <u>Taxes</u>: Renter assumes sole responsibility for the payment of any and all federal, state, and local taxes as may be applicable to Renter's use of Park Properties and Amenities and its business operations thereon. Additionally, Renter is not eligible to benefit from the County's Tax Exempt Status.
- Subcontracting: Those employed by any entity performing any work or service on behalf of Renter is considered to be a subcontractor for whom Renter is responsible. Any agreement between Renter and a subcontracting entity will be provided to the Department upon request.
- 10. No Assignment or Brokerage: Renter may not assign any rights, responsibilities, or obligations under this Agreement nor act as an agent or broker for the renting of Park Properties and Amenities. Any attempt to re-let Park Property is a material breach of this Agreement.

- 13. <u>Indemnification</u>: Renter shall protect, defend, reimburse, indemnify and hold County, its agents, servants, employees and elected officers harmless from and against any and all claims, liability, losses, expense, cost, damages and/or causes of action of every kind or character, including attorney's fees and costs, whether at trial or appellate levels or otherwise, arising during and as a result of their performance of the terms of this Agreement or due to the acts or omission of Renter.
- 14. <u>Damages</u>: If any portion of rented Park Properties and Amenities, during the term of this Agreement, shall be damaged by the act, default or negligence of the Renter, or the Renter's agents, employees, contractors, guests or any persons admitted into the Event by Renter, Renter shall pay to the County such sum as shall be necessary to restore said damaged property to its original condition. The Renter hereby assumes full responsibility for the character, acts and conduct of all Renter's employees admitted onto Park Properties and Amenities by the consent of the Renter or by or with the consent of any persons acting for or on behalf of the Renter.

Renter shall not injure, mar, nor in any manner deface Park Properties, and shall not cause or permit anything to be done whereby Park Properties shall be in any manner injured, marred or defaced; and will not drive or permit to be driven nails, hooks, tacks, or screws into any part of a park facility. Renter shall not paint anything within a park facility. Renter shall not post or exhibit or allow to be posted or exhibited, signs, advertisements, show-bills, lithographs, posters or cards of any description inside or in front of Park Properties and Amenities without the Department's prior written approval.

The County shall not be responsible for any property damage or personal injury that may result due to the Renter or the Renter's agents, servants, contractors, employees, patrons, exhibitors, contestants, guests or invitees from any cause whatsoever, prior, during or subsequent to the period covered by this Agreement; and the Renter hereby expressly releases County from and agrees to indemnify the County against any and all claims for such loss, damage or injury, except to the extent such damage or personal injury is caused by the negligence or willful misconduct of the County.

- 15. Termination Upon Destruction or other Casualty: In the event Park Properties and Amenities or any part thereof is destroyed or damaged in whole or part by fire, water, or any other cause, or if any other casualty or unforeseen occurrence renders the fulfillment of this Agreement by County impossible, this Agreement will terminate and Renter agrees to not hold County liable for any claim for damages or compensation should this Agreement be so terminated.
- 16. **Notices**: All notices required in this Agreement shall be hand delivered or sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, if sent to the County shall be mailed to:

17. **Remedies:** This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida. Any legal action necessary to enforce this Agreement shall be held in Palm Beach County, Florida. Nothing herein shall be construed as creating any personal liability on the part of any officer or agent of the County, or shall it be construed as giving any rights or benefits hereunder to anyone other

than the County and the Renter.

- 18. <u>Authorization:</u> Any individual executing this Agreement on behalf of Renter warrants he or she has full legal authority to do so, and his/her execution shall bind the Renter, its employees, agents and subcontractors to the terms and conditions herein.
- 19. <u>Arrears:</u> The Renter shall not pledge the County's credit or make it a guarantor of payment or surety for any contract, debt, obligation, judgment, lien, or any form of indebtedness. The Renter further warrants and represents that it has no obligation or indebtedness that would impair its ability to fulfill the terms of this Agreement.
- 20. <u>Public Entity Crimes:</u> As provided in F.S. 287.132-133, by entering into this Agreement or performing any work in furtherance hereof, the Renter certifies that it, its affiliates, suppliers, subcontractors and consultants who will perform hereunder, have not been placed on the convicted vendor list maintained by the State of Florida Department of Management Services within the 36 months immediately preceding the date hereof. This notice is required by F.S. 287.133(3)(a).
- 21. Severability: If any term or provision of this Agreement, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall, to any extent, be held invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement, or the application of such terms or provision, to persons or circumstances other than those as to which it is held invalid or unenforceable, shall not be affected, and every other term and provision of this Agreement shall be deemed valid and enforceable to the extent permitted by law.
- 22. Entirety of Contractual Agreement: The County and the Renter agree that this Agreement sets forth the entire agreement between the parties, and that there are no promises or understandings other than those stated herein. None of the provisions, terms and conditions contained in this Agreement may be added to, modified, superseded or otherwise altered, except by written instrument executed by the parties hereto.
- 23. <u>Waiver</u>: Failure of County to insist upon strict performance of any covenant or condition of this Agreement, or to execute any right herein contained, shall not be construed as a waiver or relinquishment for the failure of such covenant, condition, or right, but the same shall remain in full force and effect.
- 24. **Nondiscrimination:** Renter warrants and represents that all of its employees are treated equally during employment without regard to race, color, religion, disability, sex, age, national origin, ancestry, marital status, familial status, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression.
- 25. Inspector General: Palm Beach County has established the Office of the Inspector General in Palm Beach County Code, Section 2-421 2-440, as may be amended. The Inspector General's authority includes but is not limited to the power to review past, present and proposed County contracts, transactions, accounts and records, to require the production of records, and to audit, investigate, monitor, and inspect the activities of the Renter, its officers, agents, employees and lobbyists in order to ensure compliance with contract requirements and detect corruption and fraud. Failure to cooperate with the Inspector General or interfering with or impeding any investigation shall be in violation of Palm Beach County Code, Section 2-421 2-440, and punished pursuant to Section 125.69, Florida Statutes, in the same manner as a second degree misdemeanor.
- 26. Waste or Nuisance: Renter shall not commit or suffer to be committed any waste upon the Park Property or any nuisance or other act or thing which may result in damage or depreciation of value of the Park Property or which may affect County's fee interest in the Park Properties. Renter shall keep the access to the Park Property, the parking areas, driveways and other contiguous areas to the Park Property free and clear of obstruction.

27. <u>Surrender of Park Property:</u> Upon termination of use of the Park Properties by Renter, Renter, at its sole cost and expense, shall remove all of its personal property from the Park Properties and shall surrender the Park Properties to the County in at least the same condition the Park Properties were in at the start of this Agreement.



Evidence of the required insurance by way of a Certificate of Insurance shall be subject to approval by the Risk Management Department as to the form, adequacy and documentation of insurance coverage. Renter shall, at its sole cost and expense, maintain in full force and effect at all times during the life of this Agreement, insurance coverages and limits (including endorsements), as follows:

- A. Commercial General Liability with limits of at least \$1,000,000 each occurrence. Coverage shall not contain any endorsement(s) excluding nor limiting Premises/Operations, Personal Injury, Product/Completed Operations, Contractual Liability, Severability of Interests or Cross Liability. Coverage shall be provided on a primary basis;
- B. If alcoholic beverages (including beer, wine and spirits) are for sale at the event the Certificate of Insurance must state that Liquor Liability coverage is included with a minimum limit of liability of \$1,000,000 each occurrence. A liquor license is required;
- C. Workers Compensation Insurance and Employer's Liability in accordance with Florida Statute Chapter 440;
- D. Auto Liability with a minimum limit of liability of 500,000 each occurrence for all owned, non-owned, and hired automobiles;
- E. Insurers with a minimum AM Best rating of B+VIII and authorized to write insurance in the State of Florida is required.


