I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: An Interlocal Agreement (Agreement) with the Village of Palm Springs (Village) to transfer the ownership and responsibility for operation and maintenance of several annexed right-of-way segments to the Village.

SUMMARY: Approval of this Agreement will transfer the ownership and responsibility for operation and maintenance of several annexed right-of-way segments to the Village. The Agreement will also clarify operation and maintenance responsibilities for certain right-of-way segments already maintained by the Village. The annexations for these right-of-way segments were completed and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners in 2001 and 2006.

District 3 (MRE)

Background and Policy Issues: The Village adopted Resolution No. 2012-55, on July 26, 2012, and petitioned Palm Beach County (County) to enter into an Agreement for the transfer of seven right-of-way segments identified in Exhibit A. The Agreement also clarifies operation and maintenance responsibilities for four right-of-way segments identified in Exhibit B. These rights-of-way are located within the Village's municipal boundaries. The attached Agreement is consistent with the Intergovernmental Coordination Element, Objective 1.4, of the County's Comprehensive Plan. Approval of this Agreement constitutes mutual agreement by the Village and County pursuant to Section 335.0415, F.S. Staff has reviewed the request for transfer and recommends approval.



INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

THIS INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT is made on this ____ day of _____, 2012 between the VILLAGE OF PALM SPRINGS, a municipal corporation located in Palm Beach County, Florida, hereinafter referred to as "VILLAGE," and PALM BEACH COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY", each entity constituting a "public agency" as defined in Part 1, Chapter 163, Florida Statutes (2011).

WHEREAS, Section 163.01, Florida Statutes (2011), known as the "Florida Interlocal Cooperation Act of 1969," as amended, authorizes local governments to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate with other localities on a basis of mutual advantage, and to thereby provide services and facilities which will harmonize geographic, economic, population and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities; and

WHEREAS, the "Florida Interlocal Cooperation Act of 1969" permits public agencies as defined herein to enter into Interlocal Agreements with each other to jointly exercise any power, privilege, or authority which such agencies share in common and which each might exercise separately; and

WHEREAS, the annexations for the right-of-way segments identified in Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B" were previously completed and adopted by the Village of Palm Springs; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Village have determined that it is appropriate and will promote efficient provision of government services and promote public safety and welfare for the County to transfer the ownership and responsibility for operation and maintenance of certain right-of-way segments identified in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Village have determined that certain right-of-way segments are presently being maintained by the Village and it is appropriate to clarify maintenance responsibilities for certain right-of-way segments identified in Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, the right-of-way segments identified for transfer in Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B" are within the Village's municipal limits; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual obligations and undertakings, the parties do hereby covenant and decree as follows:

Section 1. Purpose

The purpose of the Agreement is to transfer the ownership, and responsibility for the operation and maintenance of certain right-of-way segments identified in Exhibit "A" from the County to the Village and to clarify operation and maintenance responsibilities for certain right-of-way segments identified in Exhibit "B".

Section 2. Definitions

The following definitions apply to this Agreement:

1. "Act" means Part 1 of Chapter 163, Florida Statutes (2011).

2. "Agreement" means this Interlocal Agreement, including any amendments or supplements hereto, executed and delivered in accordance with the terms hereof.

Section 3. Transfer of Ownership and Maintenance Responsibility of Rights-of-Way Approval of this Interlocal Agreement by both parties constitutes mutual agreement by the Village and County pursuant to Section 335.0415, Florida Statutes (2011), for the transfer of the ownership and responsibility for operation and maintenance of the right-of-way segments identified in Exhibit "A" from the County to the Village. Such transfer shall occur upon the effective date of this Agreement.

If any storm drain system travels from 10th Avenue North to the lateral and drains 10th Avenue North, Palm Beach County reserves the right to access for maintenance, the storm system for 10th Avenue North and any drainage system that links 10th Avenue North to the lateral.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Agreement shall take effect upon execution by the parties (the Village and the County).

<u>Section 5. Filing</u>

Upon execution by both parties, a certified copy of this Agreement shall be filed with the Clerk of Circuit Court in and for Palm Beach County.

Section 6. Captions

The captions and section designations herein set forth are for convenience only and shall have no substantive meaning.

Section 7. Severability

In the event any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or provision hereof is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such shall not affect the remaining portions of this Agreement, and the same shall remain in full force and effect.





RESOLUTION NO. 2012-55

A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALM SPRINGS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH PALM BEACH COUNTY, PURSUANT TO SECTION 163.01, AND SECTION 171.046 FLORIDA STATUTES, ET SEQ., FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP AND MAINTENANCE RESPONSIBILITY OF CERTAIN RIGHTS-OF-WAY, THOSE RIGHTS-OF-WAY BEING MORE FULLY DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" AND EXHIBIT "B" TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Palm Springs ("Village") deems it in the best interest of the Village to enter into that certain Interlocal Agreement with Palm Beach County for the annexation and transfer of maintenance responsibility of seven (7) road rights-of-way and clarification of operation and maintenance responsibilities for an additional four (4) road rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Village wishes to annex the seven (7) road rights-of-way and to have clarification of operation and maintenance responsibilities for an additional four (4) road rights-of-way; which are more fully described in Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B" to the Interlocal Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PALM SPRINGS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Village of Palm Springs, Florida hereby agrees to the terms and conditions of that certain Interlocal Agreement with Palm Beach County, a copy of which is attached hereto and which is incorporated herein by reference, and which is authorized pursuant to Chapter 163.01 and Section 171.046 et seq., Florida Statutes; and further authorizes the Mayor and Village Clerk to execute and deliver said Interlocal Agreement to Palm Beach County, along with a certified copy of this Resolution.

Section 2. Upon their execution, the Village Clerk shall forthwith cause a

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certified copy of this Resolution, together with a copy of the said Interlocal Agreement to be filed with the Clerk of the Circuit Court in and for Palm Beach County, Florida.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage. Section 3. walles offered the foregoing resolution.
