I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to: A) Accept on behalf of the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office an agreement with the City of Miami, as the fiscal agent for the Miami Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) to provide \$343,100 in reimbursable funding for the Regional Virtual Fusion Center effective until May 31, 2011; B) Approve a budget amendment of \$343,100 in the Sheriff's Grant Fund.

Summary: This agreement provides a means of funding various domestic security activities within the County and region using federal Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) funds through the City of Miami as the Miami UASI's fiscal agent. These funds and related equipment will be used for the Regional Virtual Fusion Center hosted by the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office. There is no match requirement associated with this award. No additional positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. Countywide (DW)

Background and Justification:

The Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) is intended is to create a sustainable national model program to enhance security and overall preparedness to prevent, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism. In general, the UASI provides financial assistance to States to address the unique equipment, training, planning, and exercise needs of large urban areas, and to assist them in building an enhanced and sustainable capacity to prevent, respond to, and recover from threats or acts of terrorism. It also includes awards to (1) selected State and local governmental entities and commercial companies to develop plans and approaches to ensuring the safety and protection of the Nation's ports, and (2) selected State and local governmental entities to develop plans and approaches to ensuring the safety and protection of the Nation's transit systems. The Catalog of Federal Domestic Assistance (CFDA) number is 97.008.



I. EXECUTIVE BRIEF

Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to receive and file: the First and Second Modifications, amending the agreement with the City of Miami, as the fiscal agent for the Miami Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) to extend the agreement period for various direct law enforcement oriented domestic security activities, from May 31, 2011, through August 31, 2012.

Summary: On March 23, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners accepted this agreement to provide \$343,100 in reimbursable funding; the original period for this agreement was January 20, 2010, through May 31, 2011 (R-2010-0426). This agenda item will extend the agreement period from May 31, 2011 through August 31, 2012. This agreement provides a means of funding various domestic security activities within the County and region using federal Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) funds through the City of Miami as the Miami UASI's fiscal agent. These funds and related equipment will be used for direct law enforcement activities. There is no match requirement associated with this award. No additional positions are needed and no additional County funds are required. Countywide (PGE)

"MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT - Modification #3"
URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE GRANT PROGRAM 2008

This Modification is made and entered into by and between the City of Miami, a municipal corporation of the State of Florida, (the "Sponsoring Agency"), and the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office, (the "Participating Agency") to reinstate and to modify the Sponsoring Agency's Memorandum of Agreement for the Urban Area Security Initiative ("UASI") Grant Program 2008, (the "Agreement"), Contract Number 10DS-48-11-23-02-195

WHEREAS, the Sponsoring Agency and the Participating Agency have entered into the Agreement, pursuant to which the Sponsoring Agency has provided sub-grants to the Participating Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement expired on August 31st, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Sponsoring Agency and the Participating Agency desire to reinstate and modify the Agreement by extending it.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

1. The Agreement is hereby reinstated as though it had not expired.
2. Section VIII, Paragraph G, Period of Agreement, is hereby amended to have an expiration date of November 30th, 2012.
3. All provisions not in conflict with this Modification remain in full force and effect, and are to be performed at the level specified in the Agreement.
4. All provisions of the Agreement being modified and any attachments thereto in conflict with this Modification shall be and are hereby changed to conform with this Modification, effective as of the date of the last execution of this Modification by both parties.




