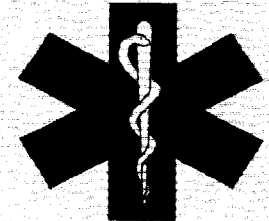
Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Palm Beach County Emergency Medical Services

WHEREAS, there is a need for Tequesta Fire Rescue to operate and provide essential emergency medical services to the citizens and visitors of Palm Beach County, Florida; and WHEREAS, said agency has applied to provide these services; and WHEREAS, said agency has indicated that it will comply with the requirements of Palm Beach County's Emergency Medical Services Ordinance (#2010-056), the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County hereby issues a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to said emergency medical service provider, valid from January 1, 2011 to December 31, 2016.

In issuing this Certificate, it is understood that the agency named hereon will meet the requirements of all pertinent county and state legislation and will provide emergency medical services on a twenty-four hour basis in the area(s) or zone(s) designated, providing the level of service endorsed as follows:



Area(s): (1) The incorporated boundaries of the Villages of Tequesta and Jupiter Inlet Colony and (2) the four (4) geographical areas that are covered by an Interlocal Agreement with Palm Beach County Fire Rescue (R- 2012-1303), as may be amended from time to time. **Area 1:** Includes all parcels south of the Village of Tequesta municipality border, east of Point Drive/ Rio Vista Drive along the Loxahatchee River, and back north along Rio Vista Drive to the Tequesta border line. **Area 2:** Includes all parcels not within the Village of Tequesta municipality boundary: east of Country Club Drive, south to Tequesta Drive, east to the Loxahatchee River, and back north to the Tequesta line. **Area 3:** Includes all parcels not within the Village of Tequesta municipality boundary, east of the Loxahatchee River, south to the Tequesta line (just north of N Dover Road), east to the Tequesta line (just west of Gardens Street), and back north to the Tequesta line. **Area 4:** All parcels within the City limits of Jupiter, south of the Village of Tequesta boundary line, east to the FEC railroad tracks, south to the Loxahatchee River, and back north along the Loxahatchee River to the Tequesta Line.
