Motion and Title: Staff recommends motion to approve: A) Expenditure of \$180,000 to complete phase 2 of the installation and twenty (20) years maintenance of thirty (30) "cobra head" streetlights within the Limestone Creek Countywide Community Revitalization Team (CCRT) area; B) Expenditure of \$40,000 to extend the maintenance for 20 "cobra head" streetlights in the Cabana Colony area for approximately 10 additional years for phase 1; C) Budget transfer of \$220,000 in the Capital Outlay Fund from the CCRT Street Lighting Project account to the Limestone Creek Street Lighting Project (\$60,000 for installation) and to the CCRT Street Lighting Maintenance Fund for Limestone Creek (\$120,000) and Cabana Colony (\$40,000); and D) Budget amendment of \$160,000 in the CCRT Street Lighting Maintenance Fund to recognize and appropriate the budget transfer from the Capital Outlay Fund.

Summary: The Limestone Creek street lighting project was initiated by members of the Limestone Creek neighborhood group. The total amount of funding provided for this project is \$180,000. Based on review by the Palm Beach County Sheriffs' Office (PBSO) and the Office of Community Revitalization (OCR) staff, it was determined that the installation of these streetlights would help reduce crime, enhance pedestrian safety and facilitate safer vehicular movement. The Cabana Colony Street Lighting project phase 1 was approved by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) on September 9, 2008. The project entailed the installation and 10-year maintenance of 20 cobra head streetlights within the Cabana Colony neighborhood. A total of \$40,000 was allocated to this project. The requested transfer of \$40,000 is needed to extend the maintenance of the lights for an additional 10 years. <u>District 1 (AH)</u>

Background and Justification: The Neighborhood Street Lighting Program (NSLP) was created to enhance crime deterrence and improve vehicular and pedestrian safety in Countywide Community Revitalization Team (CCRT) areas. Phase 1 of the Limestone Creek Street Lighting project was approved by the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) on August 15, 2006 through the allocation of \$48,000. The project, which entailed the installation of eight (8) streetlights, was completed in December of 2007. OCR received an application from the Limestone Creek CCRT area requesting additional streetlights. After review by OCR staff, the application was forwarded to the PBSO for further review and the PBSO concluded that the Limestone Creek CCRT area was qualified to receive the additional requested streetlights to deter criminal activity. The Cabana Colony neighborhood originally received through the NSLP 20 cobra head streetlights with 10 years of maintenance. Residents have requested an additional 10 years of maintenance for the streetlights, which is consistent with other CCRT neighborhood street lighting projects. The requested budget transfer in the amount of \$220,000 is needed to complete Phase 2 of the Limestone Creek Street Lighting Project and extend the maintenance period for the Cabana Colony phase 1 for an additional ten (10) years.

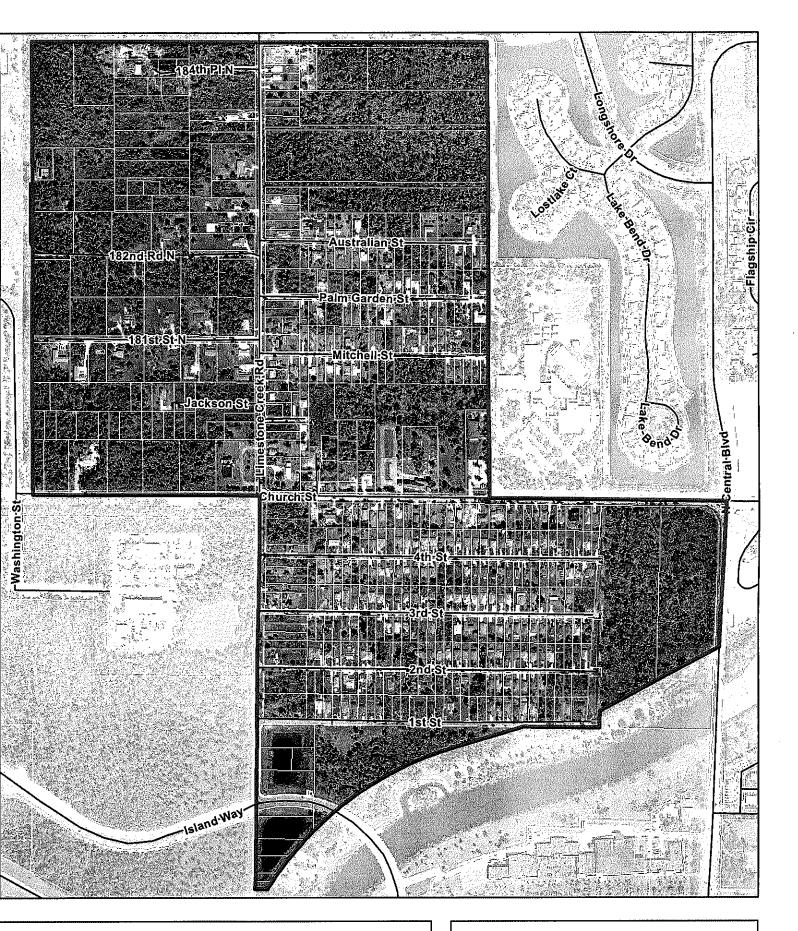
